  1. Student Semester Update Form
  2. Complete Transcript, including semester grades, semester GPA, cumulative GPA, and next semester enrollment
- After approval by the Foundation, students' next installment check will be mailed directly to their college

\*Under exceptional circumstances, accompanied with a detailed explanation, a GPA of below 3.25 might be acceptable.
