Trinity Episcopal Church is seeking a Children's Ministry Coordinator. The position of Children's Ministry Coordinator provides direction and leadership for children's ministries at Trinity from birth to 6th grade. The Children's Ministry Coordinator will initiate and maintain programs and activities that promote community, fun, and faith development in a safe and joyful environment.

The Children's Ministry Coordinator is expected to utilize a collaborative, creative approach to lead the Children's Programs in alignment with Trinity's values. We are looking for someone who is highly relational, flexible, and creates a culture of Christian belonging and love at Trinity and in the Shoals.

Collaborate: 1) Develop a core team to brainstorm, develop projects, and identify resources that serve children and families on Sunday mornings, Wednesday nights, and our Children's Summer Series. 2) Take part in big-picture conversations about church calendar, special seasons and projects, and research and curate resources to support those initiatives.

Cultivate Relationships: Invite people into volunteer opportunities that fit their gifts, interests, and expertise.

Partner with Parents: Partner with parents in raising their children by encouraging and supporting the spiritual development of their children.

Promote service: Create regular and diverse opportunities for children to serve at Trinity, in the greater Shoals community, and beyond.

Community outreach: Facilitate ways to focus church attention and resources on the next generation of children outside the walls of the church.

Qualifications

Bachelor's degree (a degree in Education, Child Development, Religion/Theology, and/or related fields is desirable but not required)

Strong leadership and organizational skills.

Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.

Passion for working with children and families.

Flexible hybrid work arrangements are possible in conversation with the Rector.
