The Parish Chef plays a vital role in Saint Stephen's ministry of hospitality, fellowship, and welcome. Working closely with clergy, staff, and a team of volunteers, the Parish Chef will provide breakfast for the congregation most Sundays and prepare a simple dinner for the community supper following the Celtic service.
