Remaining Relevant in Your Tech Career:

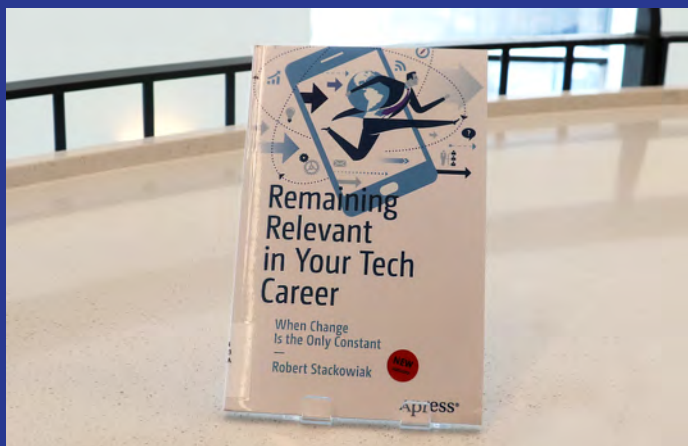
