Increase to electric vehicle registration fees

As of Jan. 1, 2026, the Michigan Motor Fuel Tax Act increases the fuel tax, which under MCL 257.801(8) requires an increase in the registration gas tax fees for plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV) and electric vehicles (EV). The fee increase will be \$53 for PHEV and \$107 for EV. A breakdown based on vehicle propulsion type follows:

- **Plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV)**

- For vehicles that weigh 8,000 pounds or less, the hybrid registration tax fee will increase from \$30 to \$83.

- For vehicles that weigh more than 8,000 pounds, the hybrid registration tax fee will increase from \$30 to \$83.

Hybrid registration gas tax fee	\$30	\$83
Total amount	\$130	\$183

- **Electric vehicles**

- For vehicles that weigh 8,000 pounds or less, the electric registration gas tax fee will increase from \$60 to \$167.

Electric registration fee	\$100	\$100
Electric registration gas tax fee	\$60	\$167
Total amount	\$160	\$267

- For vehicles that weigh more than 8,000 pounds, the electric registration gas tax fee will increase from \$60 to \$167.

Fee type	Current fee	Fee as of 1/1/2026
Electric registration fee	\$200	\$200
Electric registration gas tax fee	\$60	\$167
Total amount	\$260	\$367

Note: For Michigan vehicle dealer sales, the new fees will be generated if the delivery date is on or after Jan. 1, 2026.
