Then, he moved to Kenya, Africa, for 4 ½ years where he served as Assistant Novice Master, training young Africans in preparation for taking vows as religious brothers in the Society of Mary. Allen returned to Maui in 2012 as Associate Pastor at St. Anthony Parish. In 2015, he accepted the position of



Campus Minister at Saint Louis School back in Honolulu before retiring to Cupertino in 2021.

Allen is survived by his sister, Joan Gori of Santa Rosa; his nephew, John Gori, cousins, and grand-nephews.
