Gathering Music—We come to worship hearing joyful music.

Opening Songs—We sing songs of joy to praise the Lord.

Greeting Each Other—We share the peace of God's love with God's family.

Words for the Children—We have a special message just for you! Come on down!

The Scriptures—God's Word tells us God's story and how much God loves us.

Meditation Song—We sing a song to help us get ready to hear the sermon.

Sermon—Our pastor talks about what the scripture readings mean and how God wants us to live today.

The Offering—We give offerings to God out of gratitude for our many blessings.

Affirmation of Faith—We say what we believe as Christians.

Communion—This is sometimes called The Lord's Supper because it is linked to the Last Supper Jesus had with his disciples.

Prayers for the People and the Lord's Prayer—We pray for people and then together say the Lord's Prayer.

Closing Song—We sing a song reminding us of what we learned in the service.

Benediction—The pastor says a benediction, which means "good word," meaning GOD goes with us into the world to do God's work!
