Mr. Raney serves as editor of Hope Publishing and earned a masters degree in piano performance at The Juillard School. He has a gift for arranging and has composed numerous choral anthems, musicals and cantatas, handbell compositions, piano solos and instrumental works. Mr. Raney is a sought-after choral and keyboard clinician. He once remarked that he wanted to include AMAZING GRACE in as many compositions as he possibly could. You will hear it in this jazzy arrangement.
