**LAST TIME OUT:** **Zac Cook** drove in a career-high four runs, including his eighth home run, but the Fisher Cats fell 8-7 to Altoona on Friday night. Down 2-0, Cook hit a three-run homer to give the Fisher Cats a lead in the bottom of the second inning. Catcher **Ryan Gold** also homered in that inning to make it 4-2. The Fisher Cats took a 6-4 lead in the bottom of the third inning, putting together back-to-back doubles by **Spencer Horwitz** and **Will Robertson**. Cook's sacrifice fly produced the other run. The Curve reclaimed the lead with a three-run seventh inning. Brendt Citta singled in a run, Connor Scott doubled, and a third run scored on a passed ball. New Hampshire cut Altoona's lead to 8-7 in the bottom of the eighth inning. Cook doubled and scored on a single by **Cam Eden**. **Trent Palmer** (2.2 – 4 ER) started, and **Cre Finfrock** (0-1) took the loss.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Spencer Horwitz** went 2-for-4 with a double and has hits in 18 of his last 19 starts. Blue Jays 30<sup>th</sup> ranked prospect (MLB Pipeline) is hitting .400 this month (26 hits – 7 doubles- 4 homers and 17 walks). That's the top average in all of Double-A. OBP this month is .518 (and .407 for the season).... **Will Robertson** has the longest active hit streak on the team at seven games and has hits in 13 of his last 14 starts. Robertson left last night's game after doubling in third. He was injured on the swing and was unable to run out the play.

**START ME UP:** New Hampshire's starting pitching has been solid on the homestand. In the 10 games with Somerset and Altoona, Fisher Cat starters have allowed just 19 earned runs in 46.0 IP (3.71 ERA) with 51 strikeouts. Last night was the first time on the homestand the starter allowed more than three runs. **Luis Quinones**, scheduled to start tonight, has led the way with a 0.68 ERA (1 ER in 13.1 IP) in his four June starts.

**EVERYBODY LOVES CURVE BASEBALL:** New Hampshire plays host to Altoona, the Pirates Double-A, for the first time since May 21-23, 2019. This is the first team in the Southwest Division to visit Manchester this year. New Hampshire will host Erie, Richmond and Harrisburg in the second half of the season. The remaining six weeks of games on the road will all be played against Northeast Division rivals, Portland, Binghamton, Somerset, Hartford and Reading (2x).

**HOME STRETCH.:** The first half of the split season will end tomorrow. New Hampshire and Altoona do not figure into playoff races this week. The Northeast Division crown comes down to a series this week in Bridgewater, N.J. between the Somerset Patriots (Yankees) and Hartford Yard Goats (Rockies). Akron (Guardians), Richmond (Giants), and Erie (Tigers) could all emerge as Southwest Division champs. After last night's 5-2 win at Somerset, Hartford only needs a win tonight or tomorrow to advance to the playoffs for the first time since moving from New Britain....Akron takes a one-game lead in the Southwest over Richmond heading into play today. The Rubber Ducks win the Division with a win in either of its two games with Harrisburg. Akron has won five straight.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** June 25, 2021 – For the fourth consecutive night, the Fisher Cats scored 10 runs and beat Bowie in Maryland, 10-8. Jordan Groshans homered twice, driving in six runs. He hit a grand slam in the third inning, part of six-run frame. New Hampshire led 10-0 after his second homer, a two-run shot in the fifth. Bowie battled back, and left the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth. Max Castillo improved to 5-1 with the win. Brody Rodning notched his second save.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 19. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches have come in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of High A Spokane (Colorado Rockies) who has 20. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors is 41 (2012 and 2017).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays won 9-4 in Milwaukee last night. Cavan Biggio went 2-for-2 with a homer and Lourdes Gurriel Jr. and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. each doubled and drove in a run....Triple-A Buffalo had a walk-off 5-4 win in 10 innings over St. Paul. Chavez Young went 2-for-4 with 2 RBI. Graham Spraker (1.2 innings) earned the win in relief...Vancouver topped Hillsboro 5-3 behind two homers from Garrett Spain. Fisher Cats alum Will McAffer had the save.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats continue a franchise record 13-game homestand this week vs. Altoona. They will play in Portland next week – the final trip to Hadlock Field in 2022 for New Hampshire. The final homestand before the All-Star break will be July 4-10 vs. Hartford. That series will include a spectacular Atlas Fireworks Show on a special Monday night game – July 4. Tickets are available through the Fisher Cats website at nhfishercats.com.
