LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats ended their series against the Akron RubberDucks (Cleveland Guardians) in style on Sunday night, winning, 4-1. After a one-run outing from starter Trent Palmer, New Hampshire scored four unanswered runs for the win. Palmer, the No. 23 prospect in the Blue Jays system according to MLB.com, did not allow a hit until the bottom of the fourth inning. He allowed just one run that scored on a balk. Palmer finished with 4.2 innings of work with one hit and one earned run. He walked three, hit two, and struck out four. Reliever Andrew Bash kept Akron at one run with 2.1 innings of scoreless relief and Mike Ellenbest completed the two-hitter with his first save. Ryan Gold, Rafael Lantingua, and Tanner Morris knocked in the runs.

**OUT IN ERIE AND AKRON:** The Fisher Cats went 4-8 on the 12-game trip to Erie and Akron. New Hampshire has dropped all four of the six-game road series played in 2022. As a team, the Fisher Cats are hitting .236, tied for fifth with Hartford. The team ERA for May, at 5.38, is the highest in the EL.

WHO'S HOT: Rafael Lantigua is hitting .324 with 24 hits, 10 doubles and 13 RBIs this month. He is tied for first in the Eastern League in doubles with Altoona's Liover Peguero and Hartford's Aaron Schunk (14). Lantigua hit .200 in April. Tanner Morris' 10-game hit streak was snapped on Friday night, but he has an active 13-game onbase streak. He was 15-for-39 (.385) over his hit streak, the longest for NH in 2022. Morris is tied for first in the league in OBP (.446), tied for second in runs (32), tied for fourth in walks (29) and fifth in batting average (.319). LJ Talley went 6-for-17 with a double, two homers and three RBIs against Akron.

**T-MO, THE ON-BASE MACHINE: Tanner Morris** has reached base safely in 34 of 38 games played for New Hampshire this year. He is tied first in the league in OBP at .446. He has reached base in 18 of 20 games played in May and has a current 13-game on-base streak. Morris has hits in 12 of his last 13 games with 13 runs scored.

**ORELVIS' MAY FLOWERS: Orelvis Martinez** has been one of the best hitters in the Eastern League this month. His eight homers in May are second in the EL behind only Kerry Carpenter of Erie (12). This month, the infielder is tied for fourth in RBIs (21), 10th in slugging percentage (.564) and 15th in OPS (.908). His strikeout rate in May is 24.4%, down more than 10% from April (35.8%).

**WHAMMY (x5):** The Fisher Cats five home runs against Binghamton on May 12 was for their second five-homer game of the season. The other came in a 9-7 win at Altoona on April 23. Prior to that game, the last time New Hampshire hit five big flies at Delta Dental Stadium was July 7, 2013, also versus Binghamton. The Fisher Cats have hit five homers at Delta Dental six times in their history, with the first coming on July 18, 2006 versus Portland. They have had another four five-homer games on the road.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: May 31, 2006 – The Fisher Cats made it back-to-back shutouts with a 1-0 win over the Connecticut Defenders in Norwich. **Kyle Yates** tossed a complete game four-hitter, allowing two walks and striking out nine. New Hampshire went 0-for-11 RISP, but scored in the eighth when **Manny Mayorson** bunt singled, **Curtis Thigpen** singled, **Chip Cannon** bunted the runners up, and after an international walk of **David Smith**, **Maikel Jova** grounded into a force hit as the only run scored.

**STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook** is one HBP away from tying the Fisher Cats single-season record. Cook has been hit by 17 pitches this year, and the NH record for most hit-by-pitches in a season was set by Eric Thames in 2010 (18). Cook was the first minor leaguer on record to be hit seven times in his first six games of a season. Unfortunately, the 17<sup>th</sup> HBP, in Akron Saturday, has landed Cook on the IL for the Fisher Cats.

PROSPECTS IN MANCHESTER: New Hampshire has nine top-30 prospects on their team, according to MLB.com: Orelvis Martinez (No. 2), Adam Kloffenstein (No. 11), Hagen Danner (No. 17), Trent Palmer (No. 23), Joey Murray (No. 24), Sebastian Espino (No. 25), Hayden Juenger (No. 26) Tanner Morris (No. 29) and Spencer Horwitz (No. 30).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays (27-20) turn to **Kevin Gausman** looking for a sixth straight win in the homestand opener with the White Sox. Buffalo (30-18) has won 9-of-10 after a 7-5 win at Rochester yesterday. **Adrian Hernandez** worked two scoreless for his fifth save, and has a 0.64 ERA for the Bisons. **Cullen Large** homered for Buffalo. Vancouver will host Spokane tonight. Dunedin is at Clearwater.

**PORTLAND HERE THROUGH SUNDAY:** The Sea Dogs make the first of three visits to Delta Dental Stadium in 2022. The Fisher Cats took two-of three to open the season at Hadlock Field. Portland will back back here July 22-24, and against August 30-September 4. The Sea Dogs are 22-23, in third place in the EL Northeast. After winning 7-of-9 to start their two-week homestand, they dropped three straight to Somerset (N.Y.) Yankees. Victor Santos allowed one earned run in five innings April 9 vs. New Hampshire.

#### Tomorrow's starter

24-year old RHP Luis Quinones will make his second start of the season for the Fisher Cats on Wednesday. Did not make it out of the first inning last Wednesday (5/25) when Akron scored six in the first inning en route to an 11-8 win over New Hampshire.

Quinones opened this season on the injured list. Last season, split time between A+ Vancouver and New Hampshire. Went 2-4 with the Fisher Cats with a 5.20 ERA in 8 starts. Lost both of his starts against Portland on July 31 at Hadlock Field, and September 4 at Delta Dental Stadium.

**LAST TIME OUT**: Losing pitcher in the series opener last Tuesday morning in Akron. Allowed seven runs on eight hits in 4.1 IP, including a pair of home runs

v. PORTLAND: Started the second game of the season at Hadlock Field on April 9, holding Portland scoreless over 4.1 innings in a 3-0 New Hampshire win when also matched up against Victor Santos. Struck out four. Also made one relief appearance against Portland last Sept. 2 in Manchester, taking the loss in Portland's 3-1 win.

**2022:** First two starts were both shutout appearances. He went 4.1 innings at Portland in the second game of the season, a 3-0 win for the Fisher Cats. He made his second start against Hartford at home, earning the win with 5.0 shutout innings. He struck out four batters in each of his starts and has walked just one batter through his first 9.1 innings of work.

**2021**: Appeared in 11G, making nine starts for the Canadians (Class A Advanced). Held batters to just a .180 average and had 46 strikeouts in 42 innings, including a season-high seven against Everett on May 28. August 1 in Spokane, retired all 12 batters he faced. Threw just 48 pitches. Has been limited since missing a month with injury (June 16-July 15). Pitched for the Fisher Cats for the first time on 8/14 in Harrisburg.

**2019:** Spent first pro season at Short-Season A Vancouver, appearing in 12 games, making 10 starts. Held opponents to a .178 average.

Career/Personal Notes: 2019 All-Sun Belt Conference Second Team. Graduated from Hebron High School and named to Texas High School Baseball Coaches Association All-State Third Team as a senior.

Fastball, sinker, slider, change – Zick says the slider is his primary out pitch, especially to lefties. Wastes no time on the mound. He gets the ball and gets right after it.
