**LAST TIME OUT:** The Fisher Cats scored five unanswered runs to come back from a 3-0 deficit to win, 5-3, over the Portland Sea Dogs. **Orelvis Martinez**, **Ryan Gold**, and **Addison Barger** all sent out solo homers to spark the comeback. **Adam Kloffenstein** went 5.0 innings and gave up three earned runs, all of which came on a three-run homer from Alex Binelas. Kloffenstein also struck out 10 batters, his second-highest strikeout total in his professional career. **Andrew Bash** picked up the win with 4.0 innings of shutout relief. He walked no batters and struck out four in his second relief-win over Portland.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Addison Barger** is 13-for-30 (.433) with two homers, three RBIs and five multi-hit games across his first eight Double-A starts. **Ryan Gold** was 2-for-3 on Sunday in his fourth multi-hit game of the season. In his last six games, Gold is 6-for-15 (.400) with two homers and four RBIs. **Luis De Los Santos** has also been hot, batting 10-for-32 (.313) in his last 10 games. **John Aiello** is 11-for-38 (.289) with a double, home run and three RBIs in his last 10 games. **Parker Caracci** has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances, the longest active scoreless streak in the Eastern League.

**KLOFF DELIVERS PUNCHES:** Texas native **Adam Kloffenstein** struck out 10 batters last night against Portland, good for the most strikeouts by a New Hampshire starter this season. Kloffenstein's career-high for punchouts is 11 at Everett on August 10, 2021. Kloffenstein allowed three runs on three hits in the second inning and finished with 5.0 innings of work, five hits, three earned runs and one walk.

**PARKER'S HOUSE:** Reliever **Parker Caracci** has been nearly untouchable in his last 11 outings. Since giving up seven runs in the ninth inning against Somerset on June 16, Caracci has spun 16.0 scoreless frames. In that span, he's allowed nine hits, walked three, and struck out 18 with a 0.75 WHIP. Caracci is a product of Ole Miss, who captured the 2022 national championship. Caracci ranks fifth all-time in program history in saves with 21.

**THE NEW GUYS:** New Hampshire has welcomed five players since returning from the All-Star Break: **RHP Ryan Boyer**, **C Zach Britton**, **RHP Jake Elliott**, **IF Tyler Keenan** and **RHP Alejandro Melean**. Elliot was received from Triple-A Buffalo and has a 2-0 record and a 3.77 ERA with New Hampshire this year. The other four players were received from High-A Vancouver and have not played at Double-A. Boyer has a 2-0 record and 2.45 ERA at the time of promotion. Tyler Keenan had a .300 batting average with Vancouver, and he was traded from Seattle to Toronto in June of this year.

**WHO LET THE DOGS OUT:** The Portland Sea Dogs have taken control of the Northeast Division, going 14-6 to start the second half. The Dogs have scored an Eastern League-best 110 runs in 17 games in July. New Hampshire is 9-8 against Portland this year. The team's largest defeat (15-4, June 30) and the largest victory (16-0, July 1) were both against Portland. Also, the two largest hit outputs that New Hampshire pitching has allowed this year were both against Portland: 18 on July 22, and 15 on June 30. The Fisher Cats are batting .233 with 40 doubles and 14 homers against the Sea Dogs this year. **Rafael Lantigua** is 16-for-54 (.294) versus Portland.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** Orelvis Martinez is fourth in the Eastern League in homers with 20. More notably, he's on pace to set the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** July 24, 2014 – The last time the Fisher Cats won on a July 24 was in 2014 when they scored a 5-3 win in the opener of a four-game series at Harrisburg. They have lost six straight July 24th games since. Andy Burns hit a two-run homer in the first inning and Jon Berti knocked one out in the third for a 3-0 lead. A two-out, two-run single by Derrick Chung extended the lead to 5-0 in the seventh. Daniel Norris worked five scoreless frames, allowing only two hits, for the win. He struck out six. The Blue Jays 2nd round pick (2011) made his MLB debut for the Blue Jays on September 5 that year. Norris was released by the Cubs on Friday.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 23. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is tied for second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (28). Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system also has 23. As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors is 41 (2012).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Alek Manoah allowed one run in 6.0 IP as the Blue Jays beat the Red Sox 4-1 yesterday at Fenway. Jordan Romano finished up with a four-out save, his 21st. At Triple-A, Buffalo won 10-9 in 10 innings over Rochester. Cullen Large drew a bases loaded walk for the win. The loss went to Fisher Cats alum Patrick Murphy, who's been pitching in the Nationals system since last August.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Threw one pitch, recording an out, last Saturday in the MLB Futures Game and earned the win. Last appearance with the Fisher Cats was July 7 in a start here against Hartford. Allowed one run in four innings while striking out eight.

**v. PORTLAND:** Made his Double-A debut at Hadlock Field on June 30 and only made it 1.2 IP. Allowed two runs on two hits.

**2022:** Promoted from High-A Vancouver on June 30, the day of his first Double-A start. Made six starts against the Vancouver Canadians from May 19-June 23. Earned a 1-3 record and had a 3.80 ERA across 23.2 innings of work. He walked 11 batters and struck out 31 with the C's this season. Had two starts of 5.0 innings without allowing an earned run (5/19 vs. Tri City: 5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K AND 6/2 vs. Spokane: 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K). Began the year with Single A Dunedin where he made three starts. Had no record and a 3.00 ERA with the D-Jays.

**2021:** Zulueta faced one batter (3 pitches) with the Single-A Dunedin Blue Jays last year and tore his ACL covering first base on May 5 against the Tampa Tarpons.

**Obtained:** Zulueta was signed for \$1 million by the Blue Jays in 2019 and missed the entirety of the 2020 season rehabbing from Tommy John surgery.

**Personal:** Ranked the No. 19 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. His fastball has hit 99 mph this season, including in spring camp. His heater is regarded as one of the best pitches in the organization. His curveball is his best secondary pitch.
