**LAST TIME OUT:** New Hampshire lost their series opener with the Erie SeaWolves, 9-6, after Erie jumped out to an early 5-0 lead. SeaWolves starter Wilmer Flores was impressive, throwing 4.2 shutout innings with six strikeouts. **Orelvis Martinez** brought in three runs with a base-loaded double in the fifth, and he finished 2-for-4 with four RBIs. He and **Zach Britton** hit solo homers. Eight of Erie's nine starter had hits, and they scored in five separate innings. Quincy Nieporte hit his league-leading 27th homer.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Luis De Los Santos** has hits in 11 of his last 12 games, going 18-for-47 (.383) with five doubles and two homers in that span. **John Aiello** has an active 14-game on base streak, in which he is 19-for-51 (.373) with five doubles, one homer and seven RBIs since July 17. **Cam Eden** is 7-for-17 (.412) with two doubles, one homer, four walks and a .524 OBP during the homestand. **Addison Barger** is off to a terrific start at Double-A. In 20 starts, he has nine multi-hit games and has been held hitless just twice. He's batting .385 in 89 plate appearances with four homers. **Andrew Bash** has been stellar over the last month, going 6-0 with a 2.73 ERA, one save and a .203 BAA in his last 10 outings.

**A BIG FOUR WEEKS:** The next four weeks could likely determine New Hampshire's playoff chances. The Fisher Cats are 4.0 games back of first-place Portland. NH takes on Erie, and then the three teams ahead of them in the second-half standings in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League: third-place Hartford, second-place Somerset and first-place Portland. The four upcoming opponents are a combined 79-54 (.594) in the second half.

**THE SEAWOLVES:** New Hampshire plays Erie for the second time this season, with the first series taking place from May 17-22. The Fisher Cats have lost five of seven to the SeaWolves so far. NH struck out a franchise-record 20 times on May 20. **Phil Clarke** is 4-for-13 with a double and three walks against the SeaWolves this season. Erie has the second-best team ERA in the league (3.78) and the second-most strikeouts (1015). The last time Erie played at Delta Dental Stadium was from August 9-11, 2019. NH dropped two of three.

**LUCKY NUMBER 19:** The Fisher Cats set a new franchise record for strikeouts in a game on Thursday night, recording a whopping 19 versus Richmond. The last 13 outs the Squirrels made at the plate were all Ks. Starter **Adam Kloffenstein** had six. **Sean Mellen** had four. **Braden Scott** had six and faced seven batters across the seventh and eighth innings, and **Jimmy Burnette** finished out the night with three. The previous record for New Hampshire was 18, done twice, but both of those came in extra-inning games. The previous high for a nine-inning game was 17, most recently on July 7 versus Hartford.

**TIEDEMANN IN THE HOUSE:** Blue Jays No. 3 prospect, and No. 61 overall prospect, Tariq "Ricky" Tiedemann joined NH on Friday, throwing three shutout innings with five Ks. The 19-year-old, 6-foot-4 lefty pitched a perfect inning in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game on July 16 at Dodger Stadium. Across Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver, Tiedemann had a 2.39 ERA in 14 starts with 103 strikeouts and 13.7 K/9. He has 6+ strikeouts in 13 of his 14 starts this year, striking out a career-high 10 on May 13 vs. Tampa (Yankees Single-A). He is the youngest player in the Eastern League and second-youngest in all of Double-A.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** **Orelvis Martinez** had his third two-homer game of the season on July 28 at Binghamton, and he is second in the Eastern League lead in home runs with 25. At age 20, Martinez is the youngest of the 15 players with 20+ Double-A home runs. The second youngest are Ronny Mauricio (Binghamton, 20 HR) and Andy Pages (Tulsa, 20 HR) at 21 years old. Martinez two home runs away from the record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. Martinez's 25 are already the most by a right-handed batter in Fisher Cats history.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 26. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Rockies system (29). As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors in 41 (2012). His 26 HBP rank third in Eastern League history.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** August 10, 2011 – The Fisher Cats blanked Erie, 8-0, in a weekday matinee in Manchester. Anthony Gose and Moises Sierra homered, and John Tolisano drove in three runs. Dustin McGowan, who started New Hampshire's first-ever home game at Gill in 2004, made the start – his first for New Hampshire in over six years after battling through multiple injuries. He allowed one hit in four scoreless innings, and Rey Gonzalez improved to 7-1 with three innings of scoreless relief.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays lost, 6-5, in Baltimore despite two homers and four RBIs from Bo Bichette. The series concludes tonight- Baltimore has won a series vs. Toronto for the first time in three years. Three Fisher Cat alums combined for four innings of scoreless relief in Buffalo's 4-3 win at Syracuse. Graham Spraker, Brandon Eisert and Vinny Nittoli worked in relief. It was Nittoli's second save since returning to the Blue Jays organization.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started last Thursday night here against Richmond.

Worked four scoreless innings before being touched up in the fifth. Final line was 4.0 IP, 8 H, 5 ER, 6 K.

**v. ERIE** – Makes his second start against the Sea Wolves. Allowed four runs in 3.1 IP in his Double-A debut in a relief outing on May 21. Since then has started 11 times, still seeking first Double-A win.

**2022:** -Struck out 10 Sea Dogs in New Hampshire's 5-3 win July 23, but did not earn decision as Fisher Cats won the game late.

-Matched AA best with strong 5.2 IP at REA July 16, but lost 2-0

-Made Double-A debut in a relief outing in Erie May 21.

Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

**2021:** Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

**2019:** Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, walking 23 and striking out 64. He had a career-best WHIP of 1.09, and opponents hit .204 against him.

**2018:** Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. He threw just 2.0 innings across two starts in his rookie season.

**Obtained:** Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

**Personal:** Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
