**LAST TIME OUT:** New Hampshire is on their second longest skid of the season, having dropped the last five games. The Fisher Cats fell, 6-1, to Erie last night, and the SeaWolves locked up the series win. A pair of sacrifice flies put Erie up, 2-0, and then Parker Meadows crushed a three-run homer in the third. The Fisher Cats had just one hit through eight innings, as Erie starter Reese Olson struck out 10 batters in his first quality start of the year (6.0 IP, 0 ER). **Sean Mellen** threw a season-high 3.1 innings of shutout baseball and struck out three. **Sebastian Espino** and **Will Robertson** had hits in the ninth, and **Davis Schneider** had a single and the lone RBI. New Hampshire has scored just two earned runs on Erie starters this week in 21.2 innings.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Luis De Los Santos** has hits in 12 of his last 14 games, going 20-for-54 (.370) with five doubles and two homers in that span. **John Aiello** has an active 16-game on-base streak, in which he is 22-for-58 (.379) with five doubles, one homer and seven RBIs since July 17. Aiello's streak is tied for the second-longest by a Fisher Cat this season and is one off Tanner Morris' high of 17-games. **Cam Eden** is 9-for-30 (.300) with two homers and seven RBIs in his last 10 games. **Addison Barger** is off to a terrific start at Double-A. In 23 starts, he has 10 multi-hit games and has been held hitless just four times. He's batting .371 in 101 plate appearances with four homers.

**WE LOVE IT HERE:** With New Hampshire currently in their second 12+ game homestand of the season, the team is on pace to set a new homestand attendance record. The Fisher Cats welcomed 51,072 fans across a two-week homestand against Somerset and Atoona in June. Through nine games of the current stint, NH has had 47,434 fans in attendance. With 3,000+ fans per night over the next two nights, the total count will pass 52,000.

**THE SEAWOLVES:** New Hampshire plays Erie for the second time this season, with the first series taking place from May 17-22. The Fisher Cats have lost eight of 10 to the SeaWolves so far. NH struck out a franchise-record 20 times on May 20. **John Aiello** is 7-for-20 with two doubles and two walks against Erie this season. Erie has the second-best team ERA in Double-A (3.73), the second-best WHIP (1.16) and the second-most strikeouts (1048) and the second-best WHIP (1.22). In the first four games of the series, SeaWolves starters have a 0.83 ERA (21.2 IP, 2 ER). The last time Erie played in Manchester was from August 9-11, 2019. NH dropped two of three.

**LUCKY NUMBER 19:** The Fisher Cats set a new franchise record for strikeouts in a game last Thursday night, recording a whopping 19 versus Richmond. The last 13 outs the Squirrels made at the plate were all Ks. Starter **Adam Kloffenstein** had six. **Sean Mellen** had four. **Braden Scott** had six and faced seven batters across the seventh and eighth innings, and **Jimmy Burnette** finished out the night with three. The previous record for New Hampshire was 18, done twice, but both of those came in extra-inning games. The previous high for a nine-inning game was 17, most recently on July 7 versus Hartford.

**TIEDEMANN IN THE HOUSE:** Blue Jays No. 3 prospect, and No. 61 overall prospect, Tariq "Ricky" Tiedemann joined NH on June 5. Across two starts with NH, he's thrown 5.0 innings and given up three earned runs with seven Ks. The 19-year-old, 6-foot-4 lefty pitched a perfect inning in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Across Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver, Tiedemann had a 2.39 ERA in 14 starts with 103 Ks and 13.7 K/9. He had 6+ strikeouts in 13 of his first 14 starts this year, striking out a career-high 10 on May 13 vs. Tampa (Yankees Single-A). He is the youngest player in the league and second-youngest in all of Double-A.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** **Orelvis Martinez** had his third two-homer game of the season on July 28 at Binghamton, and he has the second-most homers in the league with 25. At age 20, Martinez is the youngest of the seven players with 20+ home runs in the Eastern League. The second youngest is Ronny Mauricio (Binghamton, 21 HR). Martinez is also two HR away from the Fisher Cats record. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. Martinez's 25 dingers are already the most by a right-handed batter in team history.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 26. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Rockies system (29). As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors is 41 (2012). His 26 HBP rank third in Eastern League history.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** August 13, 2021 – Max Castillo went six scoreless innings in New Hampshire's 7-0 win over Harrisburg at FNB Field. After a pair of walks to start the game, Vinny Capra homered to make it 3-0. Nick Podkul and Tanner Kirwer had run-scoring singles in the second for a 5-0 lead. Kirwer homered in the fourth for the other two runs.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and Cavan Biggio had doubles, two of Toronto's three hits, in an 8-0 loss to Cleveland. Logan Warmoth singled in a run in the top of the second and helped lead Triple-A Buffalo to a 3-1 win at Syracuse. Riley Tirotta hit a three-run homer, but High-A Vancouver lost at Eugene 7-4. Dunedin won 7-2 over Tampa as relievers Kelvin Perez and Nathanael Perez Lopez combined for 6.2 scoreless innings in relief with a combined nine strikeouts.
