LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats were shut out for the first time all season, as they lost, 8-0, to Reading on Saturday night. **Hayden Juenger** was tabbed for his first minor league loss, giving up four runs and two homers in 2.1 innings. **Sean Mellen** made his first Double-A appearance and allowed three runs in 2.1 innings. **Braden Scott** threw 2.2 innings, allowing just one unearned run. He delivered a strikeout to his first batter faced with bases loaded and two outs in the fifth inning. The Fisher Cats had just five hits – **John Aiello** had two of them.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Fisher Cats have scored 21 runs in first innings this season, tallying at least one run in the first frame in 11 of their 20 games. The next highest-scoring innings for the Cats are the third and fourth (14). 43 of New Hampshire's 91 runs this season are in the first three innings (47.3%).

WHO'S HOT: **Tanner Morris** is 5-for-15 with four walks in the Reading series. **Will Robertson** is also 5-for-15 with a double, home run and three RBIs. **Spencer Horwitz** is 4-for-13 with five RBIs. **Phil Clarke** is 4-for-9 with a home run and four RBIs. **Luis De Los Santos** went 9-for-18 with a homer and 7 RBIs at Altoona last week. **Tanner Morris** is fourth in the Eastern League in OBP (.446). **Orelvis Martinez** is tied for third in homers (6).

LET'S GO STREAKING: **Zac Cook** had reached base in every game played this season until April 29, good for a 15-game on-base streak. **Spencer Horwitz** has a 11-game on-base streak, and **Rafael Lantigua** had his nine-game on base streak snapped on April 28. Horwitz had a 10-game hit streak earlier this season which spanned back to his final four games of 2021 with NH. **Luis De Los Santos** had his six-game hit streak snapped in game two of the April 27 doubleheader vs. Reading.

BRING THEM HOME: The Fisher Cats have struggled to produce runs since winning the opening game of the Reading series on Wednesday night. New Hampshire enters play today 0-25 with runners in scoring position since Wednesday's game two. They went 0-6 last night.

SO CLOSE, YET SO FAR: The Fisher Cats have never won a game in which they trailed by six or more runs. They almost did on April 22 with a five-run ninth inning at Altoona, but New Hampshire lost, 8-7. The Fisher Cats had only one hit in the inning. Altoona walked five batters, hit **Zac Cook** with a pitch, had three passed balls and committed a double-error during the comeback.

ONE EXTRA, PLEASE: New Hampshire won their first extra-innings game of the season on April 20, 4-3 (10), over Altoona. The Fishers were outhit, 11-7, and struck out a season-high 16 times. The NH bullpen combined for 8.0 shutout innings, tallying 10 strikeouts. Jake Elliott earned his first win and struck out five in two frames. Spencer Horwitz had a season-high 3 RBIs, including the game-winning RBI on a groundout in the 10th.

MAX IS TOPS, AND KNOWS READING: New Hampshire's **Max Castillo** earned the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on April 18. He worked a combined nine innings in two starts in the Hartford series, allowing one hit and no runs. April 29 was Castillo's 100th appearance and 92nd start since turning pro in 2016. He has 14 wins with NH in just 25 appearances, putting him two wins shy of moving into the top-10 in Fisher Cats career wins.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: May 1, 2010 – In what was one of the craziest Fisher Cats games of all-time, New Hampshire took a 5-1 lead to the ninth inning at home against Reading, only to have the Phils score eight times in the top of the ninth to take a 9-5 lead. Domonic Brown hit a grand slam to break a 5-5 tie. In the bottom of the ninth, Eric Thames hit a three-run homer, and after a walk to Shawn Bowman, Adam Calderone walked it off with his third homer of the season in New Hampshire's 10-9 win.

STOP HITTING ME: IF Zac Cook is the first minor leaguer on record to be hit seven times in his first six games of a season. The record for most hit-by-pitches in a season was set by Eric Thames in 2010 (18). Last season, Austin Martin was hit 14 times in the 56 games he played with New Hampshire before the Blue Jays traded him to the Royals organization. Cook has been hit by nine pitches so far.

MUST-SEE ORELVIS: **Orelvis Martinez** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2022 season. He has 12 hits this season, including nine extra base hits (three doubles, six home runs). He hit six homers to lead the team in April – tied for eighth-most among all Double-A players and tied for third in the E.L. His six homers are tops in the Blue Jays minor league organization. On the downside, Martinez hit just .188 for the month, and had 12 hits with 24 strikeouts in 67 plate appearances. He walked once.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Buffalo's Samad Taylor, who played for the Fisher Cats last year, leads all of Triple-A with 12 stolen bases so far in 2022. He stole home yesterday in Buffalo's 9-7, 10-inning win at Worcester. Last season, he stole 30 bases, which was tops on New Hampshire and second most in the league. Buffalo is in first place in the International League at 14-9. Class A Advanced Vancouver went 9-9 in April and sits tied for fourth in the Northwest League. Class A Dunedin struggled at 7-13 and is in last place in the FSL West. Toronto is in second in the AL East, 1.5 games back on the Yankees.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats are off tomorrow, May 2 as they travel to Bridgewater, New Jersey for the first of two trips to the Garden State. The Fisher Cats play the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) for a six-game set starting on Tuesday, May 3.
