LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats lost to the Somerset Patriots, 4-3, on Saturday night at Delta Dental Stadium. The Fisher Cats still have not won a game in the series, as they've dropped seven in a row going back to Sunday at Binghamton. **Luis De Los Santos** and **Sebastian Espino** both had two-hit games. De Los Santos smoked a triple to dead center, and Espino hit his first homer in 18 games. **Trent Palmer** went 5.0 innings and gave up two runs on four hits, walking one and striking out seven. The seven punchouts were his most with New Hampshire this season.

WHO'S HOT: **Spencer Horwitz** had his 13-game hit streak and 16-game on-base streak snapped last night, going 0-for-3 with a sacrifice fly. In those 16 games, Horwitz was 20-for-53 (.377) with five doubles, three homers, eight RBIs and 12 walks. **Rafael Lantigua** had an 11 game on-base streak snapped on Friday, and **Zac Cook** had 10-game on base streak snapped then as well. **Will Robertson** has hits in eight of his last nine games and is 9-for-31 (.290) with six doubles and one homer in that span. **John Aiello** is 11-for-33 (.333) over his last 10 games.

SPENCE, PLAYER OF THE WEEK: First baseman Spencer Horwitz was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 13. Horwitz is third in the Eastern League and ninth among Double-A players in June batting average (.367). He is the second weekly award winner for the Fisher Cats this year along with **Max Castillo**, who won Pitcher of the Week on April 18.

WHAT DO YOU SAY, PONCE: Reliever **Gabriel Ponce** was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on Friday. He finished out his time at Double-A on a dominant stretch. In his last seven appearances, he threw 17.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run. The last earned run Ponce gave up was May 14 versus Binghamton, and one unearned run scored in his appearance at Akron on May 27. In his last seven appearances, Ponce has allowed seven hits, walked four and struck out 16. His WHIP in 11.0 innings of work in June is 0.45. At the time of his promotion, Ponce was first on the team in WHIP (0.84) among players with 15+ innings of work.

THE ELEPHANT IN THE ROOM: New Hampshire's seven-game skid is their longest since 2014, when they set a franchise record with 11 straight losses from May 11-21. Nine of those losses were by just one run. In the Fisher Cats current losing streak, they have three one-run losses and one two-run defeat. In two other games, New Hampshire and Somerset were tied going into the ninth inning. Prior to this week, New Hampshire had never been swept in a five-game series at home. With a loss today, they would be swept in a seven-game home series.

CATS AND PATRIOTS IN THE E.L.: New Hampshire has left the fewest runners on base in the Eastern League (379), though they are helped by the fact that they have played more seven-inning doubleheaders (nine) than any other team. Reading has the second-most doubleheaders with six. New Hampshire pitching is tied for second in the league in shutouts (five). Somerset leads the league home runs (82), stolen bases (106), and ERA (3.32).

HOME COOKING: With **Tanner Morris** (.338) off to Triple-A, **Spencer Horwitz** has the highest batting average at Delta Dental Stadium (.289), and he hit his second homer at Delta Dental on Friday night. His OBP at home is .411 with 25 hits, 13 walks and 2 HBP. **Orelvis Martinez** is hitting .258 at DD, and five of his 15 homers have come at home. No other player with more than 20 games played at home has a batting average above .250. **Sebastian Espino** has the most home runs at Delta Dental with six.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: June 19, 2021 – Fisher Cats 15 Yard Goats 2- The Fisher Cats scored five runs in the bottom of the second inning, and four more in the fourth to open a big early lead. Austin Martin went 5-for-6 with 4 RBI, Samad Taylor went 4-for-5 with 4 RBI and Gabriel Marino had a homer and 3 RBI. New Hampshire pounded out what would be a season-high 22 hits. Max Castillo worked six innings in relief to win.

STOP HITTING ME: **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 19. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches have come in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of High A Spokane (Colorado Rockies) who has 20. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors in 41 (2012 and 2017).

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Buffalo picked up a 3-2 win at Lehigh Valley to move back into first place in the International League's East Division. The Bisons are 37-27. Fisher Cat alums Jordan Groshans and Cullen Large each had two hits last night. Gabriel Ponce made his Triple-A debut, allowing a pair of unearned runs.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue a franchise record 13-game homestand today against the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees). With the doubleheader on Wednesday (May 7 makeup), the Fisher Cats play their first seven-game series in team history. Next week, the Altoona Curve (Pittsburgh Pirates) come to town for six games.
