LAST TIME OUT: New Hampshire pitching was stellar last night, but the Fisher Cats fell, 3-1, to Hartford. Tied, 1-1, after eight innings, Sean Rackoski (L, 4-1) allowed two runs on three hits in the top of the ninth. Both runs scored on a Hunter Stovall double. Yosver Zulueta, Thomas Ruwe, Jimmy Burnette and Rackoski combined for 17 strikeouts, a new season-high for the Cats. Thursday marked the ninth time in team history that NH had 17+ Ks. The franchise record in 18, both of which happened in extra-inning games. Zulueta had eight strikeouts in 4.0 innings, giving up just one run on a bases loaded walk. Ruwe and Burnette each struck out four. The Cats' only run scored courtesy of John Aiello, who came home from second on a wild pitch. Trevor Schwecke had two of the four New Hampshire hits, including a double in the sixth inning.

WHO'S HOT: Cam Eden had a six-game hit streak snapped last night. In that stretch, he batted 9-for-26 (.346) with two doubles, two homers and five RBIs. Eden had a single on Monday and was 2-for-5 with two doubles on Sunday. On Wednesday, Orelvis Martinez had the second two-homer day for a Fisher Cat this season (Sebastian Espino, May 12 vs. Binghamton). Rafael Lantigua hammered his first home run of the season on Wednesday, too, after being robbed of a homer by Ceddanne Rafaela at Portland last week. In his last 11 games, Lantigua is 13-for-49 (.265) with four doubles, a homer and seven RBIs. Trevor Schwecke is batting 11-for-27 (.407) with three doubles, one triple, one homer and 10 RBIs in July.

ORELVIS' BOMBS: Orelvis Martinez is tied for third in the Eastern League in homers with 19. More notably, he's on pace to set the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

SO LONG, SPENCE: First baseman **Spencer Horwitz** was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on the off-day on Tuesday. In his Triple-A debut versus Syracuse on Thursday, he went 3-for-4 with two doubles and a single in his first Triple-A at bat. He had the first five-hit game, the first five-run game, and the first five-RBI game of the season for New Hampshire last Friday night. The Blue Jays 30th ranked prospect (MLB.com) hit .370 in June with 30 hits, nine doubles, five homers and 19 walks. His batting average last month was fourth in all of Double-A, and he had a .490 OBP and a 1.157 OPS in June as well. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 13.

LAST FRIDAY NIGHT IN THE HISTORY BOOKS: New Hampshire's 16-0 win on Friday night was their largest margin of victory in a shutout in team history. The 16-run drumming was also the Fisher Cats' biggest win over Portland ever. The last time New Hampshire scored 16 runs was July 21, 2019 against Reading. **Spencer Horwitz** tied the franchise record for most hits (five) and most runs (five) in a game. He's the 11th NH player with five hits, and the first since Austin Martin on June 19, 2021. Horwitz also had NH's first five-RBI game of the year.

STARTING (AND FINISHING) STRONG: The two innings in which the Fisher Cats have scored the most runs this year are the first (57) and the ninth (49). New Hampshire is batting .293 in the first inning, the fourth-best clip in Double-A. Their 14 first-inning homers rank tied for second in Double-A, too. **John Aiello** is 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles and three walks in the first this season. **Rafael Lantigua** is 15-for-54 (.278) with four doubles in first innings this season. **Luis De Los Santos** is a stunning 11-for-20 (.550) with three doubles, one triple, one homer and eight RBIs in the ninth.

PARKER'S HOUSE: Reliever **Parker Caracci** has been nearly untouchable in his last seven outings. Since giving up seven runs in the ninth inning against Somerset on June 16, Caracci has spun 9.2 scoreless frames. In that span, he's allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out 15. Caracci is a product of Ole Miss, who captured the 2022 national championship. Caracci ranks fifth all-time in program history in saves with 21.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: July 8, 2018 – The Fisher Cats reached the Eastern League All-Star Break with a 14-2 win over Reading at Delta Dental Stadium. Four runs came across in the third, two on sacrifice flies, and two others on singles by Eduard Pinto and Jon Berti. The Fisher Cats put the game away with nine runs in the bottom of the eighth. Jonathan Davis hit a grand slam, his fifth home run of the season.

STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 22. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is tied for second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (25). Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system also has 22 this season. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors in 41 (2012 and 2017).

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Andrew Bash had a solid outing in his return to Triple-A Buffalo last night (2.2 scoreless). Chavez Young went 3-for-4 with a homer, and Danny Jansen had two hits in the Bisons 3-2 loss. For the Jays last night in an 8-3 loss at Seattle, Fisher Cat alums had nine of the ten hits including Santiago Espinal (3), Vlad Guerrero Jr. (2) and Lourdes Gurriel (2). Max Castillo worked three innings in relief, allowing one hit and one run. He struck out five.
