LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats rode **Orelvis Martinez's** second two-home run game en route to a 9-7 win over the Portland Sea Dogs on Sunday. The win locked up the series victory for New Hampshire, who won two of three games. Martinez hit a solo homer in the fourth and a three-run homer in the seventh. **Phil Clarke** drove in two runs in the sixth. Eight of the nine starters had a hit, and **John Aiello** was 2-for-4. **Sean Rackoski** earned the win in the bullpen day. **Jake Elliott** earned his third Double-A save this year in his first game with New Hampshire since June 1.

WHO'S HOT: **Addison Barger** is 14-for-33 (.424) with two homers, four RBIs and five multi-hit games across his first nine Double-A starts. In his last seven games, **Ryan Gold** is 6-for-16 (.375) with two homers and four RBIs. **Luis De Los Santos** has also been hot, batting 10-for-32 (.313) in his last 10 games. **John Aiello** is 13-for-39 (.333) with a double, home run and three RBIs in his last 10 games. **Parker Caracci** has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances, the longest active scoreless streak in the Eastern League.

KLOFF DELIVERS PUNCHES: Texas native **Adam Klobenstein** struck out 10 batters last night against Portland, good for the most strikeouts by a New Hampshire starter this season. Klobenstein's career-high for punchouts is 11 at Everett on August 10, 2021. Klobenstein allowed three runs on three hits in the second inning and finished with 5.0 innings of work, five hits, three earned runs and one walk.

PARKER'S HOUSE: Reliever **Parker Caracci** has been nearly untouchable in his last 11 outings. Since giving up seven runs in the ninth inning against Somerset on June 16, Caracci has spun 16.0 scoreless frames. In that span, he's allowed nine hits, walked three, and struck out 18 with a 0.75 WHIP. Caracci is a product of Ole Miss, who captured the 2022 national championship. Caracci ranks fifth all-time in program history in saves with 21.

THE NEW GUYS: New Hampshire has welcomed six players since returning from the All-Star Break: **RHP Ryan Boyer**, **C Zach Britton**, **RHP Jake Elliott**, **IF Tyler Keenan**, **RHP Alejandro Melean** and **RHP Andrew Moore**. Elliot was received from Triple-A Buffalo and has a 2-0 record and a 3.86 ERA with New Hampshire this year. Boyer, Britton, Keenan and Melean were received from High-A Vancouver to play at Double-A for the first time. Moore made his MLB debut with Seattle in 2017 and is now in his sixth organization (Seattle, Tampa Bay, Cincinnati, San Francisco, Detroit, Toronto).

TIME TO PONY UP: The Fisher Cats begin their third and final series against Binghamton today. New Hampshire is 7-5 against the Rumble Ponies this year, and their lone six-game road series win came at Mirabito Stadium in June. The Fisher Cats are batting .254 against Binghamton this year with 25 doubles and 15 homers. Binghamton is hitting .232 against NH with 19 doubles and 12 homers. **John Aiello** is hitting 11-for-29 (.379) with three doubles and a homer against Binghamton this year. The Rumble Ponies are in last place in the Northeast division with a 5-15 second half record.

ORELVIS' BOMBS: Orelvis Martinez is tied for second in the Eastern League in homers with 22. More notably, he's on pace to set the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: July 26, 2018 – In his next to last game with the Fisher Cats, Vladimir Guerrero Jr. hit his 13th home run in a 7-3 win at Hartford. Forrest Wall also homered for the Fisher Cats in his second at bat since being traded earlier in the day from the Yard Goats. Harold Ramirez had three doubles and Jon Berti added two triples. Eight Fisher Cats who played in that game have played in the majors this season.

STOP HITTING ME: **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 23. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is tied for second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (28). Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system also has 23. As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors in 41 (2012).

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Toronto Blue Jays enjoyed a day off yesterday and ride a six-game winning streak into tonight's game versus St. Louis. Toronto has the best team batting average in the majors (.267) and have scored the third-most runs (468) trailing only the Yankees and the Dodgers. Alejandro Kirk and Lourdes Gurriel Jr. are sixth and seventh in the majors in batting average, hitting .319 and .313 respectively. Righty starter Alek Manoah is tied for third in the league in wins with 11. Justin Verlander of Houston leads MLB with 13.

v. BINGHAMTON: First start vs. Binghamton. Making Double-A debut today.

2022: Promoted from High-A Vancouver on July 23 with a corresponding move that sent Hayden Juenger to Triple-A. Melean was 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA in nine appearances (five starts) with the Canadians. Pitched 32.0 innings with the C's, walking eight batters with 35 strikeouts. Threw best start with 5.0 shutout innings at Hillsboro on May 29. Allowed one hit, walked one, and struck out four.

2021: Spent most of the season with Single-A Dunedin before a promotion to High-A Vancouver. Had a 5-3 record in 63.0 innings with the DJays. Ended the year with a 1-1 record and 4.74 ERA in four starts (19.0 innings) with Vancouver.
