**LAST TIME OUT:** New Hampshire lost, 7-4, in their finale against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets, 21-35) on Sunday afternoon. The Fisher Cats jumped in front, 3-0, in the first inning thanks to an **Orelvis Martinez** RBI single and a **Luis De Los Santos** two-run homer. Binghamton scored four in the bottom of the seventh after four batters walked in the frame. **Spencer Horwitz** went 2-for-4 to extend his hit streak to nine games. **Zac Cook** also had two hits and drove in a run in the top of the seventh inning.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Spencer Horwitz** has a nine-game hit streak and 12-game on-base streak. In his last 12 games, Horwitz is 14-37 (.378) with four doubles, two homers, seven RBIs and 12 walks. **John Aiello** is 14-for-38 (.368) with three doubles over his last 10 games. **Zac Cook** returned from the injured list on June 8 and has a hit in five straight games since. He went 6-for-16 with a homer and three RBIs last week at Binghamton. **Will Robertson** has a double in four straight games and is tied for second on the team in doubles with 12.

**SPENCE, PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** First baseman Spencer Horwitz was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 13. Horwitz rides a nine-game hit streak into Tuesday's game with Somerset, and he went 9-for-20 last week at Binghamton. He slashed .450/.577/.900 against the Rumble Ponies. He is the second weekly award winner for the Fisher Cats this year along with **Max Castillo**, who won Pitcher of the Week on April 18. Last season, Gabriel Moreno (June), Vinny Capra (July) and Chavez Young (August) won player of the week for NH.

**WE'VE SEEN YOU BEFORE:** Somerset is the third team New Hampshire has played twice along with Portland and Binghamton. The Fisher Cats lost a five-game series, 2-3, to Somerset from May 3-8. **Orelvis Martinez** had a good week in their first series, going 4-for-16 with two homers and five RBIs. **Rafael Lantigua** had three doubles. The Fisher Cats hit .170 with six doubles and 15 RBIs against the Patriots in their first series, and the pitching staff has a 4.74 ERA versus Somerset.

**HOME COOKING:** With Tanner Morris (.338) off to Triple-A, Spencer Horwitz has the highest batting average at Delta Dental Stadium (.279) – although he has only one homer at home. His OBP at home is .410 with 19 hits, 13 walks and 2 HBP. Orelvis Martinez is hitting .253 at DD, and five of his 15 homers have come at home.

**SO LONG, T-MO:** **Tanner Morris**, one of the best hitters in the league, was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on June 8. Morris had a 17-game on-base streak in which he went 24-for-66 (.364) with seven doubles, one homer, five RBIs, 10 walks, 15 strikeouts, a .455 OBP and a .970 OPS. Morris had a 10-game hit streak within the on-base streak, too. At the time of his promotion, Morris was third in the league in OBP (.430), tied for third in runs (35), fifth in walks (30) and fifth in batting average (.312). He reached base safely in 38 of 43 games played for NH.

**IN THE FIELD:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats are smack in the middle of the Eastern League in team fielding percentage at sixth out of 12 (.979). They had four errors in a game against Portland last week. Without those, the Cats would be tied for third-fewest errors in the league but instead have the sixth fewest with 38. **Zac Cook** had a 37-game streak without an error snapped on Sunday, the eighth-longest streak in the league this year. Tied for ninth, **Spencer Horwitz** had a 36-game streak without an error snapped Thursday with a dropped catch at first.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** June 12, 2015 – The Fisher Cats opened a series in Altoona with a 14-1 win, scoring in five different innings. Dalton Pompey (pom-pay) hit a pair of homers, driving in four runs. Ryan Schimpf (shimpf) went 4-for-6 with a homer, two doubles, and three RBI. Pierce Rankin added a homer and drove in three. Starter Joel Pineiro (pin-YAIR-oh) allowed one run in seven innings for the win.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has tied the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 18. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's 18 hit by pitches have come in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of High A Spokane (Colorado Rockies) who has 19. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors is 41 (2012 and 2017).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Toronto Blue Jays thumped the Baltimore Orioles, 11-1, yesterday at the Rogers Centre behind a seven-run fifth inning. Alex Manoah earned his eighth win of the season, going 6.0 shutout innings allowing one hit. He walked one and struck out seven. Seven Jays had multiple hits in the game. Santiago Espinal went 2-for-5, and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. was 3-for-5 with a solo homer in the eighth inning. Vlad now has 15 homers this year, tied for 11th in the majors. Toronto did make three errors, including a missed catch by Guerrero on a throw from Espinal that broke his glove.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats begin a franchise record 13-game homestand today. First, New Hampshire plays the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) in a seven-game series featuring a doubleheader on Wednesday. Then, the Altoona Curve (Pittsburgh Pirates) come to town for six games.
