LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats fell, 6-5, in their second straight one-run defeat at the hands of the Portland Sea Dogs. New Hampshire trailed, 4-0 and 6-3, but came back to cut the deficit to one two separate times. **Spencer Horwitz** went 2-for-4 and extended his latest hit streak to eight games. His RBI double in the sixth inning scored **Rafael Lantigua** and put New Hampshire on the board. **Orelvis Martinez** hammered a two-run, 424' home run one batter later. **Adam Kloffenstein** was tagged with his second losing decision of the season, and both have come against Portland. He gave up a career-high 10 hits. Portland's Brian Van Belle struck out 10, and David Hamilton went 4-for-4 with a double and an RBI.

WHO'S HOT: Spencer Horwitz rides an eight-game hit streak into Thursday's game. He went 2-for-4 last night with a single and an RBI double, and he has hits in 21 of his last 22 starts. The Blue Jays 30th ranked prospect (MLB.com) is hitting .390 this month with 30 hits, nine doubles, five homers and 19 walks. His June batting average is first in all of Double-A, and he has a .510 OBP and a 1.211 OPS this month as well. In his last five games, Zac Cook is 7-for-17 (.412) with two doubles, a homer, a walk-off single and six RBIs. Will Robertson is tied for the longest active hit streak for NH at seven games and has hits in 13 of his last 14 starts. Robertson left last Friday's game after doubling in third. He was injured on the swing and was unable to run out of the batters' box.

STARTING (AND FINISHING) STRONG: The two innings in which the Fisher Cats have scored the most runs this year are the first (52) and the ninth (48). **Spencer Horwitz** leads all active Fisher Cats in first-inning batting average, going 16-for-43 (.372) with three doubles, one triple, two homers and 11 RBIs. **Rafael Lantigua** is 14-for-48 (.292) with four doubles in first innings this season. **Luis De Los Santos** is a stunning 11-for-20 (.550) with three doubles, one triple, one homer and seven RBIs in the ninth inning this year. **Orelvis Martinez** is 6-for-17 (.353) with two doubles and two homers in the ninth.

SEAN(S) OF THE PEN: Sean Rackoski and **Sean Mellen** have been two of the best relievers for the Fisher Cats of late. In Rackoski's last 10 appearances, he has a 3-0 record and a 1.42 ERA across 12.2 innings of work. He has two saves, four walks and 14 strikeouts in that span. Mellen, the lefty from Norwood, Massachusetts, has a 1-1 record and a 1.56 ERA across his last 10 outings (17.1 innings). He also has one save in that stretch with six walks and 18 strikeouts.

HELLO, OLD FRIEND: New Hampshire begins the second half of the 2022 season at the same park where they started the first half: Hadlock Field in Portland, Maine. The Fisher Cats are 6-5 versus the Red Sox affiliate this year and have won both series. The Fisher Cats are batting just .208 against Portland with 21 doubles, seven homers, and 42 RBIs, while Portland is hitting .236 with 17 doubles, four triples, four homers and 40 RBIs against New Hampshire. The Fisher Cats' team ERA against the Sea Dogs this year is 3.63.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: June 30, 2015 – The Fisher Cats beat the Sea Dogs 7-4 to open a four-game series at Hadlock Field. K C Hobson hit a grand slam in the top of third inning to get the Fisher Cats started and Dalton Pompey (pom-pay) and Kevin Nolan added sacrifice flies for a 6-0 lead in the fifth. MLB rehabber Shane Victorino had an RBI double for Portland off New Hampshire winner Joel Pineiro (jo-EL pin-YAIR-oh), the 36-year old former Major Leaguer who had signed a minor league deal with the Jays. For Pineiro, it was the ninth and final start in a Fisher Cat uniform.

STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 20. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is third in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (25) and Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system (22). As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors in 41 (2012 and 2017).

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Single A Dunedin Blue Jays and the High A Vancouver Canadians each won by one run yesterday. In Dunedin's 5-4 road over Fort Myers, Dasan Brown went 2-for-4 in the leadoff spot, and Adrian Pino was 3-for-3. Trey Cumbie earned a save and struck out the side in the ninth. Vancouver beat Spokane, 6-5, behind three first inning runs. MacKenzie Muller led the way at the plate, going 2-for-3 with an RBI. The C's were outhit, 9-6, but won to move two games below .500 at 33-35.

THE BIG LEAGUER: The Fisher Cats are scheduled to face Chris Sale tonight at a sold out Hadlock Field. The lefty ace went 5-1 with a 3.16 ERA across nine starts for the Boston Red Sox last season. He walked 12 and struck out 52 batters in 42.2 innings of work. Sale is currently on the Red Sox 60-day injured list (stress fracture, rib cage), and he is under contract with the Sox through 2024 (5-year deal, \$145 million contract). Sale won a World Series with the Red Sox in 2018 and was the 13th overall pick in the 2010 draft by the Chicago White Sox out of Florida Gulf Coast.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned a win with 5.0 one-run innings against the Hilsboro Hops on June 23. Zulueta gave up three hits, walked two batters and struck out five. He also hit a batter with a pitch. He threw 79 pitches, 48 of them for strikes. The 79 pitches were the second-most he's thrown in a game this season, behind 80 pitches versus Eugene on June 16.

v. PORTLAND: First start versus Portland

2022: Promoted from High-A Vancouver on June 30, the day of his first Double-A start. Made six starts against the Vancouver Canadians from May 19-June 23. Earned a 1-3 record and had a 3.80 ERA across 23.2 innings of work. He walked 11 batters and struck out 31 with the C's this season. Had two starts of 5.0 innings without allowing an earned run (5/19 vs. Tri City: 5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K AND 6/2 vs. Spokane: 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K). Began the year with Single A Dunedin where he made three starts. Had no record and a 3.00 ERA with the D-Jays.

2021: Zulueta faced one batter with the Single-A Dunedin Blue Jays last year and tore his ACL covering first base on May 5 against the Tampa Tarpons.

Obtained: Zulueta was signed for \$1 million by the Blue Jays in 2019 and missed the entirety of the 2020 season rehabbing from Tommy John surgery.

Personal: Ranked the No. 19 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. His fastball has hit 99 mph this season, including in spring camp. His heater is regarded as one of the best pitches in the organization. His curveball is his best secondary pitch.
