**LAST TIME OUT:** New Hampshire grinded out a 5-4 win yesterday despite going 1-for-12 with runners in scoring position in the first eight innings. **Cam Eden** delivered the game-winning RBI on a two-out single in the ninth. **Zach Britton** homered in the first inning, and **Sebastian Espino** hit a solo shot in his first game since returning from the development list. **Sean Mellen** tossed three shutout innings with six strikeouts in his third start with NH. **Parker Caracci** also worked scoreless through 2.1 frames, and **Jake Elliot** got his third win with two innings of work. He faced runners on first and third with one out in the bottom of the ninth but retired the next two batters.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Addison Barger** had his first four-hit game at Double-A yesterday, going 4-for-5 with two doubles and two singles. In his seven-game hit streak that ended on July 29, Barger was 12-28 (.429) with two doubles, four homers and eight RBIs. **John Aiello** is 7-for-19 (.368) with two doubles, two RBIs and two walks in his last five games. **Luis De Los Santos** had three hits on Thursday night and is 9-for-18 with five runs, three doubles, a homer, four RBIs and six walks in the series. He's batting .288 with six homers and 34 RBIs on the road, compared to .234 with two homers and eight RBIs at Delta Dental.

**BARGER'S SCALDING START:** **Addison Barger** has put together one of the best starts for a Fisher Cats ever. In 14 games, Barger is batting .462 with a 1.278 OPS, 24 hits, four doubles, four homers and nine RBIs. Through 14 Double-A games in 2018, Vladimir Guerrero Jr. batted .321 with a .897 OPS, and Gabriel Moreno was .382 with a 1.071 OPS in 14 games to start 2021. Barger has eight multi-hit games already and had a four- and seven-game hit streak. Barger started the season with High-A Vancouver, where he batted .300 with 21 doubles, 14 homers and 53 RBIs in 69 games. Barger was drafted out of King HS in Florida in the 2018 MLB Draft.

**LUCKY NUMBER SEVENTEEN:** New Hampshire scored a season-high 17 runs in their 17-8 victory over Binghamton on Thursday night. The previous high was 16 in their 16-0 victory over Portland at Hadlock Field on July 1. The Fisher Cats hit four homers Thursday night, three on Friday and two last night. The team has now homered in nine consecutive games, their longest streak this season. **Rafael Lantigua** homered in the first three games of the series, more than doubling his season homer count.

**THE NEW GUYS:** New Hampshire has welcomed six players since returning from the All-Star Break: **RHP Ryan Boyer**, **C Zach Britton**, **RHP Jake Elliott**, **IF Tyler Keenan**, **RHP Alejandro Melean** and **RHP Andrew Moore**. Elliott was received from Triple-A Buffalo and has a 2-0 record and a 3.63 ERA with New Hampshire this year. Boyer, Britton, Keenan and Melean were received from High-A Vancouver to play at Double-A for the first time. Moore made his MLB debut with Seattle in 2017 and is now in his sixth organization (Seattle, Tampa Bay, Cincinnati, San Francisco, Detroit, Toronto).

**TIME TO PONY UP:** New Hampshire is 10-7 against the Rumble Ponies this year, and their lone six-game road series win came at Mirabito Stadium in June. The Fisher Cats are batting .266 against Binghamton this year with 37 doubles and 28 homers. Binghamton is hitting .237 against NH with 25 doubles and 17 homers. **John Aiello** is hitting 16-for-44 (.364) with five doubles and a homer against Binghamton this year.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** Orelvis Martinez had his third two-homer games of the season Thursday night, and he is now leading the Eastern League in home runs with 24. At age 20, Martinez is the youngest of the nine players at Double-A with 20+ home runs. The second youngest is Leandro Cedenio of Amarillo at age 23. Martinez is also on pace to smash the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** July 31, 2019 – The Fisher Cats scored twice in the ninth to beat Akron 3-2 at Canal Park. Santiago Espinal drove in the first New Hampshire run with a single in the fifth, but New Hampshire trailed 2-1 entering the ninth. Chad Spanberger started the inning with a double and four walks produced the two runs with Espinal's walk putting the Fisher Cats in front. Brad Wilson earned the win with two scoreless innings in relief.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 24. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (28). As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors in 41 (2012). Cook's 24 HBP rank fourth in Eastern League history.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays beat the Tigers 5-3 and play for a series win today. Teoscar Hernandez hit a three-run homer in the sixth which was the game-winner. Fisher Cat alum Drew Hutchison had a solid start for Detroit, allowing one run in 5.0 innings. Jordan Romano earned his 23rd save. LJ Talley hit a three-run homer in the eighth as Buffalo rallied past Worcester, 5-3. Trey Cumbie went 3.0 shutout frames in relief to earn the win as Dunedin beat Clearwater 3-1.
