LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats earned their second one-run win of 2022, beating Reading, 2-1. **Max Castillo** earned his third win of the season in his 100th minor league appearance, throwing 6.0 innings and allowing one run. **Will Robertson** and **Ryan Gold** hit back-to-back home runs in the fifth inning. The game lasted 2:17, making it the shortest nine-inning game of New Hampshire's season.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Fisher Cats have scored 21 runs in first innings this season, tallying at least one run in the first frame in 11 of their 19 games. The next highest-scoring innings for the Cats are the third and fourth (14). 43 of New Hampshire's 91 runs this season are in the first three innings (47.3%).

WHO'S HOT: **Tanner Morris** is 5-for-12 with three walks in the Reading series. **Will Robertson** is 4-for-12 with a double, home run and three RBIs. **Spencer Horwitz** is 4-for-10 with five RBIs. **Phil Clarke** is 4-for-9 with a home run and four RBIs. **Luis De Los Santos** went 9-for-18 with a homer and 7 RBIs at Altoona last week. **Tanner Morris** is second in the Eastern League in OBP (.457). **Orelvis Martinez** is tied for third in homers (6).

LET'S GO STREAKING: **Zac Cook** had reached base in every game played this season until April 29, good for a 15-game on-base streak. **Spencer Horwitz** has a 10-game on-base streak, and **Rafael Lantigua** had his nine-game on base streak snapped on April 28. Horwitz had a 10-game hit streak earlier this season which spanned back to his final four games of 2021 with NH. **Luis De Los Santos** had his six-game hit streak snapped in game two of the April 27 doubleheader vs. Reading.

INTRODUCING THE FISHER BATS: New Hampshire hit a season-high five long bombs at Altoona on April 23, their most in a game since July 7, 2013 (vs. Binghamton) and one short of the franchise mark (six, June 2, 2010 at Reading). The Fisher Cats hit 11 homers in the six-game set versus Hartford and had at least two homers in each of the four wins. The team hit .291 for the series with 48 hits in 165 AB. **Orelvis Martinez** and **Zac Cook** each hit three HR in the series. **Sebastian Espino** drove in eight runs in the series, hitting a pair of homers.

SO CLOSE, YET SO FAR: The Fisher Cats have never won a game in which they trailed by 6+ runs. They almost did on April 22 with a five-run ninth inning at Altoona, but New Hampshire lost, 8-7. The Fisher Cats had only one hit in the inning. Altoona walked five batters, hit **Zac Cook** with a pitch, had three passed balls and committed a double-error during the comeback.

ONE EXTRA, PLEASE: New Hampshire won their first extra-innings game of the season on April 20, 4-3 (10), over Altoona. The Fishers were outhit, 11-7, and struck out a season-high 16 times. The NH bullpen combined for 8.0 shutout innings, tallying 10 strikeouts. Jake Elliott earned his first win and struck out five in two frames. Spencer Horwitz had a season-high 3 RBIs, including the game-winning RBI on a groundout in the 10th.

MAX IS TOPS, AND KNOWS READING: New Hampshire's **Max Castillo** earned the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on April 18. He worked a combined nine innings in two starts in the Hartford series, allowing one hit and no runs. April 29 was Castillo's 100th appearance and 92nd start since turning pro in 2016. He has 14 wins with NH in just 25 appearances, putting him two wins shy of moving into the top-10 in Fisher Cats career wins.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: April 30, 2018 – The Fisher Cats opened a three-game series at home with Reading with a 7-2 win. Jordan Romano (W, 4-0) started, allowing two runs in 5.0 innings. He struck out seven but did walk five. Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Cavan Biggio and Harold Ramirez all had two hits in the win. Guerrero and Biggio hit back-to-back triples in the third inning to tie the game, 2-2.

STOP HITTING ME: IF **Zac Cook** is the first minor leaguer on record to be hit seven times in his first six games of a season. The record for most hit-by-pitches in a season was set by Eric Thames in 2010 (18). Last season, Austin Martin was hit 14 times in the 56 games he played with New Hampshire before the Blue Jays traded him to the Royals organization. Cook has been hit by nine pitches so far.

MUST-SEE ORELVIS: **Orelvis Martinez** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2022 season. He has 12 hits this season, including nine extra base hits (three doubles, six home runs). The 20-year-old Dominican Republic native made 16 plate appearances in spring training and slashed .308/.400/1.323 with two home runs. One of Martinez's two dingers was against Phillies pitcher Aaron Nola.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Buffalo's Samad Taylor, who played for the Fisher Cats last year, leads all of Triple-A with 11 stolen bases so far in 2022. Last season, he stole 30 bases, which was tops on New Hampshire and second most in the league. The player who ranks second in stolen bases in Triple-A is Forrest Wall of Tacoma with 10. Wall played for the Fisher Cats in 2018 and 2019 and joined the Mariners organization this spring.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats conclude their series vs. Reading tomorrow, May 1. On Monday, May 2, they'll travel to Bridgewater, New Jersey for the first of two trips to the Garden State. The Fisher Cats play the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) starting on Tuesday, May 3.
