LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats lost, 5-3, to the Somerset Patriots in the third straight game decided by one or two runs. NH once again got out to an early lead but could not hold on. **Orelvis Martinez** finished with two hits and two RBIs, including a solo homer in the sixth. **Hayden Juenger** pitched 3.0 near-perfect innings, allowing just one baserunner on a walk. Juenger has not allowed a run in four of his six outings this year. He and **Braden Scott** combined for a no-hit bid that lasted until two outs in the bottom of the fifth. **Zac Cook** made a diving catch on the right field line in the sixth. **Gabriel Ponce** (L, 0-1, BS) retired the first four batters he faced but hit Derek Dietrich with a pitch to begin a two-out Somerset rally. The Patriots would score three in the eighth to win.

SO CLOSE, YET SO FAR: The 8-7 loss at Somerset on Tuesday featured a third ninth-inning comeback that came up one run short for NH. On May 1, the Fisher Cats scored four runs in the ninth inning versus Reading but fell, 10-9. The Fisher Cats have also never won a game in which they trailed by six or more runs. They almost did on April 22 with a five-run ninth inning at Altoona. NH lost, 8-7. The Fisher Cats had only one hit in the inning.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Fisher Cats have scored 27 runs in first innings this season, tied for sixth-most in the minors. The Fisher Cats are batting .340 in the first inning with eight homers, 14 walks, 25 RBIs and a .437 OBP (1st in minors). They have tallied at least one run in the first frame in 14 of 24 games. The next highest-scoring inning for NH is the third (15). 52 of the Fisher Cats' 113 runs this season are in the first three innings (46.0%).

WHO'S HOT: **Orelvis Martinez** has four homers and 11 RBIs in his last 10 games, hitting 9-for-40 (.225). He is tied for first in the league in homers with eight. **Tanner Morris** is 13-for-36 (.361) in his last 10, as he's drawn six walks and notched a .452 OBP. He has hits in six of his last seven games, including four multi-hit starts. Morris is fourth in Double-A and first in the Eastern League in OBP (.467). He is also sixth in the league in walks with 18. **Will Robertson** is 11-for-34 over his last 10 with two homers and six RBIs. **Luis De Los Santos** has four multi-hit games on the road, and he has three hits in the Somerset series. Luis went 9-for-18 with a homer and seven RBIs at Altoona, and nine of his 10 RBIs are on the road.

WHO'S NOT: **Sebastian Espino** is 4-for-35 (.114) over his last 10 with three doubles, a homer and 24 strikeouts. Steward Berroa is 2-for-23 over his last 10, and both hits were bunt singles on May 1 versus Reading.

WHERE STREAKS END, NEW ONES BEGIN: **Tanner Morris** has a nine-game on-base streak. **Will Robertson** has a five-game hit streak, and **Chris Bec** has a four-game hit streak. **Zac Cook** had reached base in every game played this season until April 29, good for a 15-game on-base streak. **Spencer Horwitz** had a 12-game on-base streak snapped Tuesday. Horwitz had a 10-game hit streak earlier this season spanning back to 2021.

MAX IS TOPS: New Hampshire's **Max Castillo** earned the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on April 18. He worked a combined nine innings in two starts in the Hartford series, allowing one hit and no runs. April 29 was Castillo's 100th appearance and 92nd start since turning pro in 2016. He has 14 wins with NH in just 25 appearances, putting him two wins shy of moving into the top-10 in Fisher Cats career wins.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: May 8, 2009 – The Fisher Cats followed up a 12-0 win over New Britain the day before with an 18-6 win over the Connecticut Defenders in Manchester. Brian Doparik (doe-PAIR-ick) had the single best offensive day in team history with two doubles, a triple, two homers and 8 RBI. Originally a second round draft pick of the Cubs out of Dunedin High School, the Blue Jays signed him. He never played in the Major Leagues.

STOP HITTING ME: **Zac Cook** is the first minor leaguer on record to be hit seven times in his first six games of a season. The record for most hit-by-pitches in a season was set by Eric Thames in 2010 (18). Last season, Austin Martin was hit 14 times in the 56 games he played with New Hampshire before the Blue Jays traded him to the Royals organization. Cook has been hit by 10 pitches so far this year.

MUST-SEE ORELVIS: **Orelvis Martinez** is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2022 season. He has 16 hits this season, including 10 extra base hits (three doubles, seven home runs). He has hit eight homers to lead the team and is tied for fifth-most among all Double-A players and tied for first in the E.L. His six homers in April were tops in the Blue Jays minor league organization. Martinez hit just .188 for the month and had 12 hits with 24 strikeouts in 67 plate appearances. He walked once last month.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: New Hampshire's all-time winningest pitcher, Casey Lawrence, pitched in relief for the Blue Jays on Thursday against Cleveland after being called up from Triple-A Buffalo. The now 34-year-old worked 1.1 scoreless innings in what was his 39th career MLB appearance, but first with Toronto since 2017. Lawrence was signed as a non-drafted free agent in June of 2010. He made 74 appearances and 69 starts for the Fisher Cats between 2012 and 2021. His 25 wins are the most by a New Hampshire pitcher in a career.

COMING UP: NH begins their only May homestand versus the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets). The series starts May 10.

The move completes a past move between the two clubs, as Schultz was the player to be named later in a February trade that saw Derek Fisher head from Toronto to Milwaukee.

The Fisher Cats are off tomorrow. They are expected to start Hayden Juenger (ying-er) on Tuesday versus Binghamton. It will be his 6th pro start.

Blue Jays 6th round draft pick in 2021 (Missouri State) is just 21 years old.

Juenger worked three near-perfect frames against Somerset his last time out, as just one base runner reached on a walk. He has 25 strikeouts in 16.1 innings.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third win of the season in his 100th minor league appearance. Castillo gave up just one run in six innings of work and worked out of multiple jams with runners in scoring position. He became the second NH pitcher to toss over 90 pitches in an outing with 91 versus the Fightin Phils.

v. SOMERSET: Made a pair of starts against Somerset in May 2021. In his first outing, Castillo earned the win with 5.0 innings of work, allowing just one earned run and striking out four. His second start was in game one of a doubleheader at Somerset, and he got the hook after just 0.2 innings. In that start, Castillo gave up four earned runs, walked three, and struck out none. He gave up a solo homer to first baseman Dermis Garcia.

OF NOTE: Castillo's 11 wins in 2021 were the most by any pitcher in Double-A last season.

2022: Named EL Pitcher of the Week (4/18) after working 9.0 IP, allowing only one hit and no runs in two starts against the Yard Goats.

2021: Spent the entire season in the Fisher Cats rotation and made every start. Had a winning record every month May-August. Improved his career record to 40-17, all in the Blue Jays system. Went to Venezuelan Winter League, appeared in 12 games (1-1, 2.33 ERA) for Lara.

2019: Made 24 starts for Adv. A Dunedin, working 130.1 IP. Went 11-5 with a 2.69 ERA and was named a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star

2018: Went 10-5, 4.52 ERA in 28 games, 22 starts for Class-A Lansing. Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star.

2017: 10 starts for Rookie League Bluefield. Went 6-0, 3.80 ERA.

2016: Pitched in four games for DSL Jays before heading to Bluefield, where he made nine starts, and went 2-3, 4.62 ERA.
