**LAST TIME OUT:** The Fisher Cats won a thrilling pitchers' duel, 1-0, behind a masterclass from **Paxton Schultz**, who threw 6.2 shutout innings. Friday was the deepest a New Hampshire starter has gone in a game this season and marked a career-high in innings for Schultz. He allowed six hits, five of them from Johan Camargo (MLB rehabber) and Jhailyn Ortiz (9-for-13 in the series). Schultz threw 96 pitches, 66 of them strikes, and came out with runners on second and third with two outs in the seventh. **Andrew Bash** got the third out to preserve Schultz's shutout, throwing 2.1 innings in his first save at Double-A. The Fisher Cats only run came in the sixth inning when **Cam Eden** doubled **Ryan Gold** home.

**WHO'S HOT:** **Addison Barger** is 8-for-15 (.533) with one RBI across his first four Double-A starts. **Davis Schneider** has an active five-game hit streak, during which he's hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, one homer, two RBIs and two walks. **John Aiello** has an active five-game hit streak, too. The Wake Forest product reached base in 11 consecutive games, tied for his longest on-base streak this season. In those 11, Aiello is 11-for-42 (.262) with eight runs scored, three doubles, one triple, one home run, two RBIs, six walks and nine strikeouts. **Parker Caracci** has not allowed an earned run in his last 10 appearances, the second-longest active scoreless streak among Eastern League pitchers. He trails only Blake Rivera of Richmond (11).

**PARKER'S HOUSE:** Reliever **Parker Caracci** has been nearly untouchable in his last 10 outings. Since giving up seven runs in the ninth inning against Somerset on June 16, Caracci has spun 14.2 scoreless frames. In that span, he's allowed eight hits, walked three, and struck out 18 with a 0.75 WHIP. Caracci is a product of Ole Miss, who captured the 2022 national championship. Caracci ranks fifth all-time in program history in saves with 21.

**SCHULTZ'S START OF THE YEAR:** Yesterday, **Paxton Schultz** finished with the best pitching line of a Fisher Cats starter all year, going 6.2 innings with six hits, no runs, no walks and three strikeouts. He threw 96 pitches and 66 strikes, becoming the first starter to work into the seventh inning this season. In his first seven appearances (six starts), Schultz has a 2-4 record and 6.49 ERA, giving up eight homers in that span. In his last eight appearances (seven starts), Schultz is 4-0 with a 2.91 ERA, allowing just one home run. This month, Schultz has a 2-0 record with a 0.57 ERA and 0.77 WHIP.

**A PITCHING COACH'S DREAM:** New Hampshire's 1-0 win last night was their first by that score since August 19, 2019, when the Fisher Cats beat Trenton on the road, 1-0. **Joey Murray** got his second win of the season, throwing 5.2 shutout innings in relief with six hits and six strikeouts. Zach Logue started the game with two shutout frames. New Hampshire had four 1-0 wins in the 2019 season, including back-to-back victories at Binghamton.

**AGAINST THE R-PHILS:** New Hampshire is now 4-6 against Reading this season. In seven of their 10 games against Reading, New Hampshire has scored two runs or fewer. The Cats 16 hits on Thursday were their most against the Phils all year, while their seven runs were their second-most scored against Reading. Among the active roster, the Fisher Cats have hit .245 with 11 doubles, six homers, and 29 RBIs against Reading. The active Fightins are hitting .274 with 17 doubles and 13 homers. **John Aiello** (6-for-21) and **Phil Clarke** (5-for-17) have the best averages against Reading among players with at least five games played.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** Orelvis Martinez is fourth in the Eastern League in homers with 19. More notably, he's on pace to set the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** July 16, 2008 – For the first time, the Fisher Cats hosted the Eastern League All-Star Game at what was then called Merchants Auto.com Stadium. The teams were divided into the North and South, which is how the league was split at the time. Three Fisher Cats were in the starting line-up – Scott Campbell (2B), Travis Snider (RF) and Brian Jeroloman (C) (jir-AH-luh-min). The North won 5-3 thanks to a three-run homer by New Britain's Luke Hughes in the sixth.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 23. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is tied for second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (28). Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system also has 23. As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors is 41 (2012).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The 2022 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game is 7 p.m. ET today at Dodger Stadium. It's a seven-inning game, American vs. National League. Pitchers Yosver Zulueta and Ricky Tiedemann represent the Blue Jays. Reading's Logan O'Hoppe and Erik Miller are in LA as well.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not figure in the decision on Sunday in a 10-7 loss to Hartford. Worked the first four innings, allowing two runs on two hits. The first two for the Yard Goats reached- Hunter Stovall single and a Daniel Montano homer. Left with the game tied 2-2. Walked four and struck out five.

**v. READING** – Has not faced the Fightin Phils

**2022:** Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

**2021:** Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

**2019:** Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, walking 23 and striking out 64. He had a career-best WHIP of 1.09, and opponents hit .204 against him.

**2018:** Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. He threw just 2.0 innings across two starts in his rookie season.

**Obtained:** Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

**Personal:** Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
