**LAST TIME OUT:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats evened up the series with the Hartford Yard Goats, winning, 6-2, on Friday night at Delta Dental. **Rafael Lantigua** went 3-for-3 with a two-RBI double in the fifth inning that put the Fisher Cats in front, 4-2. **Davis Schneider** had his first multi-hit game at Double-A, going 2-for-3 with a double and two runs scored. **Phil Clarke** had two hits in his first game since June 24 versus Altoona. **Braden Scott** earned the win with 2.0 scoreless innings and five strikeouts. **Parker Caracci** finished out the game with his eighth straight scoreless appearance.

**WHO'S HOT:** On Wednesday, **Orelvis Martinez** had the second two-homer day for a Fisher Cat this season (**Sebastian Espino**, May 12 vs. Binghamton). **Rafael Lantigua** hammered his first home run of the season on Wednesday, too, after being robbed of a homer by Cedanne Rafaela at Portland last week. In his last 12 games, Lantigua is 16-for-52 (.307) with five doubles, a homer and nine RBIs. **Trevor Schwecke** is batting 11-for-31 (.355) with three doubles, one triple, one homer and 10 RBIs in July.

**K-CITY:** Fisher Cats pitching has totaled 67 strikeouts over the last six games, tied with Birmingham for the most in Double-A. New Hampshire has struck out at least 10 batters in six of the last seven games. Over the last two games, the staff has combined for 31 punchouts, including a season-high 17 in a 3-1 loss to Hartford on Thursday night. **Yosver Zulueta** (8), **Braden Scott** (5), **Parker Caracci** (4) and **Thomas Ruwe** (T-4) have all notched season-highs for strikeouts in a game this week.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS:** Orelvis Martinez is tied for third in the Eastern League in homers with 19. More notably, he's on pace to set the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season. 12 players have hit at least 20 homers in a season for the Fisher Cats, most recently Cavan Biggio with 26 in 2018.

**SO LONG, SPENCE:** First baseman **Spencer Horwitz** was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo on the off-day on Tuesday. In his Triple-A debut versus Syracuse on Thursday, he went 3-for-4 with two doubles and a single in his first Triple-A at bat. He had the first five-hit game, the first five-run game, and the first five-RBI game of the season for New Hampshire last Friday night. The Blue Jays 30th ranked prospect (MLB.com) hit .370 in June with 30 hits, nine doubles, five homers and 19 walks. His batting average last month was fourth in all of Double-A, and he had a .490 OBP and a 1.157 OPS in June as well. He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 13.

**STARTING (AND FINISHING) STRONG:** The two innings in which the Fisher Cats have scored the most runs this year are the first (58) and the ninth (49). New Hampshire is batting .292 in the first inning, the fourth-best clip in Double-A. Their 14 first-inning homers rank tied for second in Double-A, too. **John Aiello** is 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles and three walks in the first this season. **Rafael Lantigua** is 16-for-55 (.291) with four doubles in first innings this season. **Luis De Los Santos** is a stunning 11-for-20 (.550) with three doubles, one triple, one homer and eight RBIs in the ninth.

**PARKER'S HOUSE:** Reliever **Parker Caracci** has been nearly untouchable in his last seven outings. Since giving up seven runs in the ninth inning against Somerset on June 16, Caracci has spun 10.2 scoreless frames. In that span, he's allowed six hits, walked one, and struck out 16. Caracci is a product of Ole Miss, who captured the 2022 national championship. Caracci ranks fifth all-time in program history in saves with 21.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** July 9, 2014 – Casey Lawrence allowed one run over 7.2 innings as the Fisher Cats topped the New Britain Rock Cats 7-1 at Delta Dental Stadium. Michael Crouse (KRAUS) and Dalton Pompey (pom-pay) hit homers for the Fisher Cats – both coming off current Blue Jays starter Jose Berrios, who was making his Double-A debut.

**STOP HITTING ME:** **Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 22.

Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is tied for second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (25). Esteury Ruiz of the Padres system also has 22 this season. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors is 41 (2012 and 2017).

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Lourdes Gurriel Jr. had three hits, driving in a run, and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. drove in the other in Toronto's 5-2, 10-inning loss to the Mariners. Eugenio (ay-you-HEN-ee-o) Suarez hit the walk-off homer off Sergio Romo. For Seattle Fisher Cat alum Ryan Borucki (bo-RUCK-ee) pitched 2.0 innings of scoreless relief to earn the win.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started last Sunday in Portland. Worked 3.1 scoreless innings, allowing just a pair of hits. Fisher Cats fell in the game 4-2, and Schultz did not figure in the decision. He had a short outing making his first start since injured sliding to make a play against Altoona June 21.

**v. HARTFORD:** Started the first game of the April 17 doubleheader in Manchester against the Yard Goats, taking the loss in Hartford's 4-1 win. Gave up three homers in that game (MacLver, Herron, Datres).

**2021:** Spent the entire season in the rotation for Adv. A Vancouver, making 21 starts. Went a career-best six innings five times. Struck out 114 in 102.1 innings, including nine batters twice in June against Eugene. Did allow 108 hits and 45 walks with a 1.50 WHIP.

**2019:** Appeared in nine games (one start), working 23.1 innings for the Rocky Mountain Vibes (Rookie League).

**Career/Personal Notes:** Earned Academic All-WAC honors for the third time. Tied a Utah Valley single-season record with 99 strikeouts in 2019. Struck out 11 batters in a game against South Carolina. Prepped at Orem (Utah) High School. As a senior in 2016 named first-team All-State after going 11-1 with a 2.90 ERA. Also batted .426 with 11 doubles and 31 RBIs.

**Obtained:** Selected by the Brewers in the 14<sup>th</sup> round of 2019 draft (Utah Valley). The Blue Jays acquired Schultz from the Brewers 5/2/21. The move completes a past move between the two clubs, as Schultz was the player to be named later in a February trade that saw Derek Fisher head from Toronto to Milwaukee.
