LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats won their second straight game over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Friday night. New Hampshire tallied 10 hits in the win, including home runs from **Spencer Horwitz** and **Orelvis Martinez**. Horwitz left the yard for the first time since April 23 at Altoona, and Martinez became the first player in the Eastern League to hit double-digit home runs (10). **Paxton Schultz** threw a season-high 5.0 innings and struck out a season-high eight batters, one off his career high. Seven of the nine Fisher Cats registered hits, and **Tanner Morris**, Martinez and Horwitz each had multi-hit games. It was the team's sixth game with 10+ hits.

WHAMMY (x5): The Fisher Cats five home runs against Binghamton made for their second five-homer game of the season. The other came in a 9-7 win at Altoona on April 23. Prior to last night, the last time New Hampshire hit five big flies at Delta Dental Stadium was July 7, 2013, also versus Binghamton. The Fisher Cats have hit five homers at Delta Dental six times in their history, with the first coming on July 18, 2006 versus Portland. They have had another four five-homer games on the road.

THREE STRAIGHT AT THE PLATE: Sebastian Espino homered in his last at bat on Wednesday against Binghamton and then in his first two at bats of Thursday's game. He is the second known Fisher Cat to homer in three consecutive at bats. Michael Negron did so in a three-homer game against Binghamton in 2005.

WHO'S HOT: Sebastian Espino is 4-for-10 with three homers in the Binghamton series. Luis De Los Santos is 8-for-26 (.308) with two multi-hit games over his last eight games. He has five multi-hit games this year. Orelvis Martinez has four homers and 11 RBIs in his last 10 games, hitting 12-for-36 (.333). He is first in the league in homers with 10. Tanner Morris is 11-for-37 (.297) in his last 10, as he's drawn seven walks and notched a .409 OBP. He started May with back-to-back three-hit games. Morris is third in the Eastern League in OBP (.439). He is also fifth in the league in walks with 22.

ONE IS BETTER THAN NONE: The second game of the May 8 doubleheader at Somerset was the 17th time the Fisher Cats have been one-hit. New Hampshire's staff has throwing three two-hitters this year, including game one on Mother's Day against the Patriots.

SO CLOSE, YET SO FAR: The 8-7 loss at Somerset on Tuesday featured a third ninth-inning comeback that came up one run short for NH. On May 1, the Fisher Cats scored four runs in the ninth inning versus Reading but fell, 10-9. The Fisher Cats have also never won a game in which they trailed by six or more runs. They almost did on April 22 with a five-run ninth inning at Altoona. NH lost, 8-7. The Fisher Cats had only one hit in the inning.

MAX IS TOPS: New Hampshire's **Max Castillo** earned the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on April 18. He worked a combined nine innings in two starts in the Hartford series, allowing one hit and no runs. April 29 was Castillo's 100th appearance and 92nd start since turning pro in 2016. He has 14 wins with NH in just 25 appearances, putting him two wins shy of moving into the top-10 in Fisher Cats career wins.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: May 14, 2011 – Anthony Gose and Mike McDade hit homers as the Fisher Cats outlast the Phils 13-10 at First Energy Stadium in Reading. McDade's three-run homer in the sixth gave the Fisher Cats a 12-1 lead. Reading scored in three straight innings, but Bobby Korecky set them down in order in the ninth to preserve the win.

STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook is the first minor leaguer on record to be hit seven times in his first six games of a season. The NH record for most hit-by-pitches in a season was set by Eric Thames in 2010 (18). Last season, Austin Martin was hit 14 times in the 56 games he played with New Hampshire before the Blue Jays traded him to the Royals organization. Cook has been hit by 12 pitches so far this year. The New Hampshire Fisher Cats have been hit by 27 pitches this season, the most in the Eastern League.

MUST-SEE ORELVIS: Orelvis Martinez is ranked the No. 2 prospect in the Blue Jays system to start the 2022 season. He has 24 hits this season, including 13 extra base hits (three doubles, 10 home runs). He has hit 10 homers to lead the team and is tied for second-most among all Double-A players and first in the E.L. His six homers in April were tops in the Blue Jays minor league organization.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Vinny Capra got his first big-league hit last night with a single into right field versus Tampa Bay. Capra is 1-5 across five games with Toronto. The most recent Fisher Cats alum to play in the Big Leagues is reliever Danny Young, who debuted on Monday for the Mariners against Philadelphia. He tossed 2.1 scoreless innings. Young is the 146th Fisher Cat to make his MLB debut after playing in New Hampshire, and fifth this season along with Zach Jackson (RHP, Athletics, 4/9), Zach Logue (LHP, Athletics, 4/19), Christian Lopes (Athletics, 4/20), Vinny Capra (IF/OF, Blue Jays, 5/1). Danny Young was a member of the EL Champion Fisher Cats in 2018 – and 18 players from that team have now gone on to play in the Majors.

COMING UP: NH closes their series with Binghamton (New York Mets) tomorrow to end their only full homestand of May. Next up, the Cats have a two-week road trip to Erie, Pennsylvania and Akron, Ohio to face the SeaWolves (Tigers) and RubberDucks (Guardians).
