LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats lost, 8-1, in their series opener with the Richmond Flying Squirrels last night at Delta Dental Stadium, despite trailing just 3-1 after eight innings. Rafael Lantigua was 3-for-5 with his teamleading 23rd multi-hit game of 2022. Luis De Los Santos drove in Addison Barger in the eighth with a double, but New Hampshire went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position. Brett Auerbach homered off Alejandro Melean in the fourth, and Tyler Fitzgerald took Yosver Zulueta deep in the fifth. In one stretch in his relief outing, Luis Quinones retired seven consecutive batters with five straight strikeouts. Carter Aldrete smacked a grand slam in the ninth, though, and Richmond pulled away for the win.

WHO'S HOT: A pair of Fisher Cats take seven-game hit streaks into tonight's game. Luis De Los Santos has hits in seven straight games and is 11-for-25 (.440) with four doubles, one homer and five RBIs in that stretch. He hit .338 in July with 26 hits in 77 at bats. Rafael Lantigua is also at a seven-game hit streak, in which he's 9-for-27 (.333) with three home runs. After hitting .300 in 69 games with Advanced-A Vancouver, Addison Barger is off to a terrific start at Double-A. In 16 games, he's 26-for-59 (.441) with four doubles and four homers. Orelvis Martinez led the Fisher Cats with seven homers and 15 RBI in July, hitting .184 for the month. 10 of his 14 hits were for extra bases.

**BIG TIME POWER:** The Fisher Cats hit a whopping 17 home runs in the Binghamton series. **Rafael Lantigua** led the way with three homers, and **Davis Schneider**, **Addison Barger**, **Orelvis Martinez** and **Zac Cook** all hit two. New Hampshire finished July with 40 home runs in just 24 games. That appears to be the most in a calendar month in franchise history (team hit 38 in August 2007). New Hampshire hit a homer in 10 straight games before last night and had hit at least two homers in eight straight. The Fisher Cats earned a series win on the road for only the second time in 2022 after winning four of six. Both road six-game series wins have come in Binghamton. New Hampshire finished off a winning month (13-11) for the first time in 2022.

THE NEW GUYS: New Hampshire has welcomed six players since returning from the All-Star Break: RHP Ryan Boyer, C Zach Britton, RHP Jake Elliott, IF Tyler Keenan, RHP Alejandro Melean (tonight's starter) and RHP Andrew Moore. Elliot was received from Triple-A Buffalo and has a 3-0 record and a 3.26 ERA with New Hampshire this year. Boyer, Britton, Keenan and Melean were received from High-A Vancouver to play at Double-A for the first time. Moore made his MLB debut with Seattle in 2017 and is now in his sixth organization (Seattle, Tampa Bay, Cincinnati, San Francisco, Detroit, Toronto).

IT'S NUTS: These are the first games between New Hampshire and Richmond since the Fisher Cats swept a three-game series at The Diamond June 14-16, 2019. Richmond is 20-10 all-time in New Hampshire, which doesn't include a split of two games the teams played in the 2011 Eastern League Championship Series (won by the Fisher Cats). The Flying Squirrels, who have already secured a spot in the 2022 playoffs by finishing in first place in the first half of the season, lead the all-time series with New Hampshire, 34-25.

**ORELVIS' BOMBS: Orelvis Martinez** had his third two-homer games of the season last Thursday night, and he leads the Eastern League with 24 home runs. At age 20, Martinez is the youngest of the 11 players with 20+ Double-A home runs. The second youngest are all 23 (Leandro Cedeno of Amarillo, Michael Toglia of Hartford and Moises Gomez of Springfield). Martinez is also on pace to smash the single-season home runs record for the Fisher Cats. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) are tied for the crown with 27 in a season.

**STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook** has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 26. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Colorado Rockies system (28). As far as stats go to 1988, the record for HBP in a season in the minors in 41 (2012). His 26 HBP rank third in Eastern League history.

**THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY:** August 3, 2021- The Fisher Cats opened a home series with Hartford with an 8-2 win. Samad Taylor led off and went 3-for-3. His bunt single and error in the bottom of the fifth started a three-run rally to put New Hampshire in front. Nick Podkul added a two-run homer in the seventh. Starter Riley Hovis allowed two runs (one earned) in five innings for his second win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays won 3-1 at Tampa Bay last night as Kevin Gausman had a dominant start. He allowed just one hit over eight innings, while striking out ten. Bo Bichette knocked in the first run with a single and Danny Jansen added a two-run single in the top of the ninth. Jordan Romano came out of the pen for his 25th save after being named AL Reliver of the Month for July (0.84 ERA, seven saves, .114 BAA, 12 K). At Triple-A, Buffalo won 4-0 at Scranton/Wilkes Barre. Tanner Morris and Cullen Large each had two hits an RBI. Vancouver fell 3-0 to Tri-City. Dunedin was rained out at Lakeland. They'll play two today.

Prepped at Orem (Utah) High School. As a senior in 2016 named first-team All-State after going 11-1 with a 2.90 ERA. Also batted .426 with 11 doubles and 31 RBIs.

Obtained: Selected by the Brewers in the 14<sup>th</sup> round of 2019 draft (Utah Valley). The Blue Jays acquired Schultz from the Brewers 5/2/21. The move completes a past move between the two clubs, as Schultz was the player to be named later in a February trade that saw Derek Fisher head from Toronto to Milwaukee.
