LAST TIME OUT: The Fisher Cats gave up seven runs in the ninth inning in their 11-4 defeat to the Somerset Patriots last night. Somerset walked twice and had five hits (including four extra base-hits) in the final frame. The seven-run inning was tied for the most scored in a frame against New Hampshire this year (fifth inning of game two on 4/21 at Altoona). **Nick Fraze** carried a no-hit bid into the fifth and finished with 5.0 innings, three hits, two earned runs, one walk and seven strikeouts. Thursday was Fraze's second game with seven or more strikeouts, topped only by nine at Erie on 5/17. **Phil Clarke** and **LJ Talley** both hit two-run homers, putting NH up, 4-0.

WHO'S HOT: Spencer Horwitz has the longest hit streak of the Fisher Cats' season, currently at 12 games. He has also reached base in 15 straight games. In his last 15 games, Horwitz is 19-49 (.388) with five doubles, two homers, seven RBIs and 13 walks. Rafael Lantigua has reached base in 11 straight games, and Zac Cook has an active 10-game on base streak. Will Robertson and Orelvis Martinez had season-long hit streaks snapped last night. Robertson hit safely in six straight. In each game, he had an extra-base hit (five doubles, one homer). He was 7-for-19 (.368) in that span. Martinez had his second five-game hit streak, going 7-for-18 (.388) with three doubles, one homer and three RBIs. John Aiello is 11-for-34 (.324) over his last 10 games.

SPENCE, PLAYER OF THE WEEK: First baseman Spencer Horwitz was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 13. Horwitz rides a 12-game hit streak into Thursday's games with Somerset, the second-longest active streak in the league behind Portland's Pedro Castellanos (13). Horwitz is first in the Eastern League and fourth among Double-A players in June batting average (.405). He is the second weekly award winner for the Fisher Cats this year along with **Max Castillo**, who won Pitcher of the Week on April 18.

WHAT DO YOU SAY, PONCE: Reliever Gabriel Ponce was promoted to Triple-A Buffalo today. He finished out his time at Double-A on a dominant stretch. In his last seven appearances, he threw 17.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run. The last earned run Ponce gave up was May 14 versus Binghamton, and one unearned run scored in his appearance at Akron on May 27. In his last seven appearances, Ponce has allowed seven hits, walked four and struck out 16. His WHIP in 11.0 innings of work in June is 0.45. At the time of his promotion, Ponce was first on the team in WHIP (0.84) among players with 15+ innings of work.

WE'VE SEEN YOU BEFORE: Somerset is the third team New Hampshire has played twice along with Portland and Binghamton. New Hampshire is 2-7 versus Somerset, though neither team has found their groove at the plate. NH is hitting .201 with 14 doubles, eight homers and a slash line of .201/.282/.345 against Somerset. Somerset is hitting .215 with 15 doubles, six homers and a slash line of .215/.311/.352. New Hampshire's pitching staff has a 5.56 ERA versus Somerset.

CATS AND PATRIOTS IN THE E.L.: New Hampshire has left the fewest runners on base in the Eastern League (372), though they are helped by the fact that they have played more seven-inning doubleheaders (nine) than any other team. Reading has the second-most doubleheaders with six. New Hampshire pitching is tied for second in the league in shutouts (five). Somerset leads the league home runs (80), stolen bases (101), and ERA (3.33).

HOME COOKING: With Tanner Morris (.338) off to Triple-A, Spencer Horwitz has the highest batting average at Delta Dental Stadium (.303), although he has only one homer at home. His OBP at home is .418 with 24 hits, 13 walks and 2 HBP. Orelvis Martinez is hitting .256 at DD, and five of his 15 homers have come at home.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: June 17, 2018 – The Fisher Cats took over sole possession of first place (40-29) with a 9-1 win in Altoona. Jonathan Davis doubled to start the game, scoring on a Bo Bichette groundout. New Hampshire then plated six in the fourth for a 7-0 lead. Juan Kelly homered in the frame and Gunnar Heidt had a two-run single. Cavan Biggio hit his 15th home run of the season in the ninth inning. Jon Harris allowed one run in six innings for the win.

STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook has tied the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 18. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's 18 hit by pitches have come in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all of the minors, behind Braiden Ward of High A Spokane (Colorado Rockies) who has 19. As far as stats date to 2005, the record for hit by pitches in a season in the minors in 41 (2012 and 2017).

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Buffalo Bisons retained sole possession of first place in the International League with a 3-2 win last night over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. Mike Ellenbest, promoted from New Hampshire last week, earned a hold with 0.2 innings of work. Adrian Hernandez picked up his eighth save of the season and seventh with Buffalo with 1.2 innings and three strikeouts. Hernandez leads all Blue Jays minor leagues in saves and is tied for fifth in Triple-A.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue a franchise record 13-game homestand today against the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees). With the doubleheader on Wednesday (May 7 makeup), the Fisher Cats play their first seven-game series in team history. Next week, the Altoona Curve (Pittsburgh Pirates) come to town for six games.

2022: Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

2021: Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

2019: Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, walking 23 and striking out 64. He had a careerbest WHIP of 1.09, and opponents hit .204 against him.

2018: Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. He threw just 2.0 innings across two starts in his rookie season.

Obtained: Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

Personal: Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
