LAST TIME OUT: New Hampshire suffered their second straight home sweep with a 5-0 loss to the Portland Sea Dogs (Boston Red Sox) on Sunday. The highlight for New Hampshire came in the top of the seventh, when the Cats nearly turned a 6-2-5-4-3-1 triple play. **Jimmy Robbins** (L, 0-2) gave up two early homers that proved to be the difference. **John Aiello** had a double in his first start of the series, and **Orelvis Martinez** had two hits. The Fisher Cats have now lost a team record 13 consecutive home games. They are 5-20 in their last 25 games.

WHO'S HOT: John Aiello has an active 25-game on-base streak, in which he is 34-for-89 (.382) with eight doubles, three homers and 11 RBIs. Aiello's streak is the longest by a Fisher Cat this season and is the second longest active streak in the league. Davis Schneider had a nine-game hit streak snapped on Sunday, but a walk extended his on-base streak to 22 games. In that stretch, he's 30-for-86 (.349) with three homers and 14 RBIs. Luis De Los Santos had his eight-game hit streak snapped as well with an 0-for-3 day. He was 9-for-32 with a homer and four RBIs over those eight games. Jimmy Burnette has 13 strikeouts across his last five appearances (6.1 innings).

RAIN, RAIN: New Hampshire and Reading were rained out last night, and today the Fisher Cats play their first doubleheader since June 15 versus Somerset. This is New Hampshire's first doubleheader of the second half. The last rainout the Fisher Cats saw was June 7 at Binghamton.

A WHOLE LOTTA HOMERS: The Fisher Cats are up to 149 home runs in 2022, a new single-season team record. The previous high was 144 by the 2007 team. Even more remarkable, the Fisher Cats broke the record in 1,000 fewer at bats (3,877 AB for 145 HR in 2022, 4,877 AB for 144 HR in 2007). New Hampshire also has the most road home runs in a season with 78, surpassing their previous high of 72 in 2011. The most Fisher Cats home runs at Delta Dental Stadium came in 2007, when they hit 79. New Hampshire currently has 70 homers at home.

ORELVIS IS KING: **Orelvis Martinez** broke the Fisher Cats single season home run record on August 21 with a seventh inning, two-run blast at Dunkin' Donuts Park, his 28th long ball of the season. Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010) each had 27 homers. Thames needed 560 plate appearances, Cannon needed 524 PA, and Martinez needed 391 PA to reach 27 dingers. Martinez has four two-homers games this season, and he's second in the league in homers behind Erie's Quincy Nieporte (30). At age 20, Martinez is the youngest of the 11 players with 20+ home runs in the Eastern League. The second youngest is 21-year-old Ronny Mauricio (BNG, 24 HR).

RICKY ON THE SHELF: The Toronto Blue Jays moved No. 2 prospect **Ricky Tiedemann** to the development list on August 28, possibly signaling the end of his game action in 2022. In four starts and 11.0 IP at Double-A, Tiedemann allowed three earned runs, all of which came against Erie. He threw back-to-back scoreless, hitless starts at Hartford and Somerset. Across three levels this year, the 20-year-old struck out 117 batters in 78.2 innings (13.4 K/9) with a 0.86 WHIP. He struck out a season-high 10 batters versus Tampa on May 13 in 5.0 innings.

AGAINST THE SEA DOGS: New Hampshire is 4-8 against Reading this season, and they've lost both series four games to two. **John Aiello** has more hits (nine) against Reading than any other player, and he's hitting .310 (9-for-29) with one double in the season series. **Gabriel Ponce** has not allowed an earned run in 8.0 innings against the Fightin Phils. Jhailyn Ortiz is 14-for-38 (.368) with six doubles and one homer against the Fisher Cats this season. New Hampshire is hitting .239 with seven homers against Reading, while the Fightin Phils are hitting .280 with 13 homers against NH.

STOP HITTING ME: Zac Cook has broken the New Hampshire single-season record for hit by pitches with 28. Eric Thames was hit by 18 pitches in 2010, but that was in 573 plate appearances over 130 games. Cook's first 18 hit by pitches came in 139 plate appearances and 36 games. Cook is second in HBP in all the minors, behind Braiden Ward of the Rockies system (33). His 28 HBP are tied for second in league history. He had just one HBP in August after 26 in April-July.

THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS' HISTORY: September 7, 2018 – The Fisher Cats finish off a three-game sweep of Trenton to advance to the Eastern League Championship series with a 5-1 win at ARM & HAMMER Park. Jordan Romano allowed one unearned run in his 5.2 innings to pick up the victory. Cavan Biggo had a pair of hits, driving in three runs and Patrick Cantwell had three hits.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Orioles scored five in the third inning and held off the Blue Jays, 9-6, last night. Bo Bichette continued his tear, going 4-for-5 with a homer and two RBI. Alejandro Kirk also had four hits. Alek Manoah looks for his 14th win tonight vs. Orioles. Triple-A Buffalo was rained out at home with Gwinnett. High-A Vancouver lost 8-5 but the magic number to clinch a playoff berth is down to one. Class-A Dunedin fell at home to Palm Beach 4-3.

WHIP 1.09. .204 average against. 2018: Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

Obtained: Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus. Personal: Ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
