### Support work placement while taking Child Development classes to obtain your Associate Teacher Certificate and Permit

#### Associate Teacher Apprenticeship

#### Tuition is FREE. This program is of NO COST to the apprentice.

Jump-start your Early Childhood Education career. Starting Fall 2023, The Sonoma County Early Childhood Education SCECE Apprenticeship is a unique paid learning and on-the-job training experience where participants will earn 12 Early Childhood Education units through Santa Rosa Junior College, complete 2,000 hours of paid work experience, and will be eligible for an Associate Teacher Permit.

#### Program Benefits:

- Embedded classroom tutoring
- Job placement with local employers, including:
  - 4C's Sonoma,
  - Santa Rosa Junior College,
  - Child Family Community Inc
  - CAP Sonoma Head Start
  - North Bay Children's Center

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Success Coaches will work with you step-by-step to ensure you have what you need to succeed

#### Eligibility Criteria:

- Be 18 years or older
- Pass a criminal background and fingerprint check
- Provide immunization record
- Pass a physical health screening
- Have evidence of a negative tuberculosis test



#### Quick Facts:

- Includes a combination of on-the-job learning and coaching as well as in-class instructional learning
- No Cost
- Enrollment in and completion of the apprentice program increases Staff Qualifications on ECE Career Pathway
- Excellent opportunity for employees with unrelated degrees to increase their qualifications
