Paraeducator Supervision Academy (PSA) - a one day training that enables the educators and other school professionals to develop a core of communication, collaboration, problem solving, and supervisory skills needed to work with para-educators. PSA focuses on research-based strategies for establishing and working relationships and assessing personal supervisory skills. It also includes approaches to building work and instructional plans, identifying training for para-educators through needs assessment, and using feedback to improve the job performance of para-educators.

Barbara Stimson and her husband Jeff reside in Lakewood CO. They have two adult **children**, one granddaughter and two much loved dogs. Barbara retired several years ago after 35 years as a special educator in public schools.
