COURSE DESCRIPTION Students will learn PSAT/SAT Math content (geometry, measurement, proportions, and percent); test-taking strategies; and how to practice for the exam.

THEME: BRIDGE TO COLLEGE AND CAREER In addition to preparing for the PSAT and SAT, students will learn valuable time management, test-taking, and study skills that will benefit them in college.

INSTRUCTOR

When Jennifer Ledwith graduated from college without needing to take out student loans, she realized the massive amount of student loan debt that her friends and classmates took on to get an education. She created Scholar Ready in 2004 to help future students avoid taking on unnecessary student debt. Originally, she focused on helping with scholarship essay writing; however, realizing that scholarships are a function of several factors - PSAT scores, ACT scores, SAT scores, GPA, and essays - she expanded Scholar Ready's services to include math tutoring and test preparation. Jennifer believes that education and literacy skills are the foundation of a successful life and strives to instill those beliefs in her students.
