Nursery – one position filled. Kendra Blount will be the lead nursery person. She has a ton of experience at the "Y" leading the child care there.


Bookkeeper Added – Donna Allen has been brought on board to fill the bookkeeper position. Donna is a teacher at Fox Valley Tech in the Math Department.





## MISSION QUILTS SOME IMPORTANT GUIDELINES TO REMEMBER

- LWR Mission Quilts should measure approximately 60" x 80". This size best serves adult recipients and children as they grow older. Please donate only 60" x 80" quilts.
- The ultimate purpose of a quilt is to provide warmth, so please choose your fabrics accordingly. Even in warmer climates, temperatures can drop dramatically at night.
- Quilt tops and bottoms can be made from whole pieces of fabric or any type of patchwork pattern or smaller squares.

Twelve 21" or forty-eight 11" squares sewn together using a 1/2" seam allowance make a 60" X 80" top. Cut or sew bottoms 64" X 84" as this allows for a required edging on the quilt.

• Keeping in mind that LWR quilts will be washed frequently and used for many purposes, we recommend sturdy, washable fabrics such as cotton, cotton blends, twill, corduroy, and polyester knits. Please ensure that there are no stains or holes before using fabrics in a quilt.

- Please do not donate items with any religious symbols, messages or your congregation's name.
- Please do not donate any items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or references to the armed forces, including camouflage.




