From the Pastor's Desk . . .

It's back! What's back you're probably asking?

Well Holy Communion is what's back at Our Saviour's.

Starting on Sunday Aug. 2, Holy Communion will be back as part of our weekly worship service.

This letter will do 3 things in regards to our temporary renewed Holy Communion practice:

- ◆ Nuts and bolts of how it will work
- ◆ A how to "Set the Table" for celebrating the Sacrament at home (how to prepare)
- ◆ Invite you to use the OSLC Communion Bread recipe at home as a way of creating community

Nuts & Bolts and how to "Set the Table"

1. Prepare your worship space. If you can, light a candle and seat

yourself comfortably. Pour only enough wine/grape juice as you will consume during Holy Communion. Put out either the circle of Communion bread that you have made or use whatever bread you have, again just enough for the service. Any leftover wine/grape juice and bread should either be totally consumed following worship or placed outside (poured on the ground – NOT thrown in the trash or dumped down the drain). Wash the cup (chalice) and plate (paten) afterwards.

2. I will start the Communion liturgy and say the Words of Institution at church as part of the virtual worship. For the distribution that you will do in your homes I will say on camera, "the body of Christ given for you"; "the blood of Christ shed for you". In your home you can repeat that to com-

mune each other by sharing bread and wine (grape juice). I will then offer a post communion blessing from church for everyone.

3. For those who are not part of our virtual services, use this same information and at 9:30 a.m. every Sunday morning, commune yourself/yourselfes, thereby being part of the communing community even if you're not online.

The Communion bread recipe follows. You don't have to use this if you do not want to.

This is an unusual way to celebrate the Sacrament and we're only using it for the time being until we can be back worshipping together. When that happens, we'll no longer be communicating virtually.

Grace and Peace – *Pastor Kurt*

OSLC Communion Bread recipe (makes 8 round "loaves")

Halve recipe if you'd like.

Combine in a bowl:

3 cups all purpose flour
1 cup whole wheat flour
2 teaspoons baking soda
2 teaspoons salt
6 tablespoons sugar = 1/3 cup

Add:

6 tablespoons oil = 1/3 cup
1 and a half cups of water (slightly below the line)



Instructions:

Mix all together well and divide into 8 balls. Knead on a lightly floured surface. Shape into 5" by a half" thick disk. Score (cut a cross into the top surface of your loaves. Bake 10-12 minutes at 350 degrees on an ungreased baking sheet. These freeze very well.





Monthly Reports:


- Pastor Kurt's written report was submitted.

⇒ We will need supplies, such as Hand Sanitizer, Thermometers, Cleaning supplies.


- Pastor Kurt and Brett will continue with daily devotions on Facebook, 9am and 12 noon. Laura will fill in on the days they are unable to participate.


