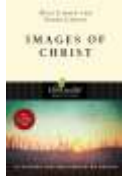

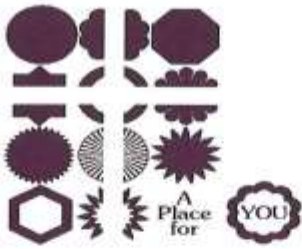

With gas prices up and grocery prices rising, the OSLC Little Free Pantry is getting a lot of use! Staff sees people at the "blessing box" nearly every time we come and go. There are folks taking the food they need, and others who bring groceries to add to the pantry.

You can donate **food that doesn't spoil** for the OSLC Little Free Food Pantry at any time. Please bring it to OSLC and place directly into the Little Free Pantry if there is room. We also have a pantry cupboard in the Narthex for overflow food items when you come to church.

Your BASICS Committee is caring for creation in numerous ways. They are looking for Project Managers, list makers, follow-uppers.

BASICS is in need of 4, yes **Four**, Project Managers! Yikes. 4 members that are super Project Managers, like to make lists, and love to follow through on a pet project. The four areas are:

- ◇ Little Free Food Pantry
- ◇ Dunlap/Lincoln School liaison
- ◇ World Relief Afghan Refugee liaison
- ◇ Salvation Army liaison

(The finer print):

1. The Little Free Food Pantry needs someone that will monitor donations, (did you know we are always accepting donations?), and stock the pantry as needed. This is on-going and needs to be looked after regularly. (Our pantry is used quite often by those in need within our neighborhood.)
2. Dunlap School will require coordinating needs with the school principal,

and scheduling volunteers for service projects. Email is a great tool for this job! Work from home!

3. World Relief / Afghan Refugee liaison, mostly work from home. Letting the congregation know what needs to be collected.
