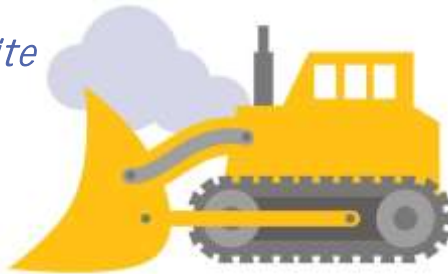

Installation for Pastor Kemp: October 27th, this is a Thursday at 6:30PM. There will be bars, etc. Synod office has given us the order of service for the installation

New Business:

Stewardship Month: Stewardship drive theme will be Growing in Gratitude. Drive will begin October 2nd. Details are within the Stewardship report. Looking for members to give short testimonials of how OSLC has impacted their lives to share in church. Ministry fair to be held October 16 and 23.

Capital Campaign: 2 bids have been received from companies to help run our campaign. Long discussion was held. Will consider inviting companies to answer questions at a Council meeting.

Property Updates: Air conditioning units have been repaired. Some members have expressed concern about weeds within in our lawn—Joel has been investigating estimates for lawn treatment. It was agreed to get lawn treated—motion

approved. There is a memorial planter at the entrance of the church to honor the parents of Toni Hoh. A door in the church has been left unlocked multiple times over the last several months. Numbering of the exterior doors is in process.
