Dear Friends in Christ,

Gordon W. Lathrop, ELCA pastor and retired seminary professor of liturgy recently published a new book entitled: *The Assembly: A Spirituality*. He writes: "The most important symbol of Christ in the room (sanctuary) is not the minister, not the altar, not even the bread and wine or the water of the font. It is the assembly, the Body of Christ, as the New Testament says".

As I reflect on the past two years and our need to re-assemble as a faith community, I am aware that we need to address not only the WHAT but also the WHY of communal worship. Reflecting on the painful time of the pandemic, when most churches were not assembling in-person, I am convinced that public worship now is more important than ever.

For us to live out our mission to: "Love God, Love Others", we need this time together to remember, as we pray, "who we are and to whom we belong". We also need to be renewed and recharged to go out and be Christ to others.
