## FAITH BASED INFORMATION SHARING & ANALYSIS ORGANIZATION



**Founded in late 2020, the HAtE Crimes Community ENGagement Working Group is a partnership between the Faith-Based Information Sharing and Analysis Organization (FB-ISA0), the InfraGard National Capital Region and New York Metro Members Alliances, with support from the Executive Partnership for Integrated Collaboration (EPIC) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation’s New York and Washington field offices.**

Hate crimes often have a broader effect than most other types of crime. Hate crime victims include not only the immediate target, but also families, communities, and at times, the entire nation. Unfortunately, the vast majority of hate crimes go unreported.

The HAtE Crimes Community ENGagement Working Group (HACCEN) was formed to raise awareness of hate crimes or bias incidents in communities and to share real-time information about threats, incidents, indicators, trends, and best practices to mitigate risks associated with hate crimes.

Led by a steering committee of volunteers representing their communities and organizations, HACCEN develops, fosters, and facilitates public-private partnerships and provides them with a trusted environment to speak directly and candidly, peer-to-peer, to share real-time information and intelligence, via a listserv. Members are enabled to more effectively prevent



or respond to hate crimes in their communities.

Periodic webinars, which are archived for future reference, complement the real-time exchange between members.

Membership is unique.

It is for **individuals**, not organizations. This facilitates an organic growth of trust among members, leading to the frank exchange of information.

In addition, business development is strictly prohibited.

### Membership requirements

You can join HACCEN if you

- are in a position to access and potentially share threat information and/or best practices for mitigating hate crimes

**AND**

- will not use this group to market or promote for-profit or commercial products and services

**AND** you meet at least one of the following criteria:

- You are a current InfraGard member or have an application pending
- You are an active member of the FB-ISA0
- You have a verified affiliation with an advocacy or community group that has been approved by the HACCEN Steering Committee
- You are the employee of any government or law enforcement agency (federal, state, local or tribal) and have a government or law enforcement email address
- You otherwise ask to join with an explanation that's approved by the HACCEN Steering Committee
