

Essential Businesses

- A. Healthcare Operations and Essential Infrastructure;
- B. Pharmacies and other healthcare stores;
- C. Businesses or manufacturers that supply other essential businesses with the support or supplies necessary to operate;
- D. Industrial Manufacturers;
- E. Grocery Stores, certified Farmers' markets, farm and produce stands, supermarkets, food banks, convenience stores, liquor stores and other establishments engaged in the retail sale of canned food, dry goods, fresh fruits and vegetables, pet supply, fresh meats, fish , poultry and other household consumer products (such as cleaning and personal care products). This includes stores that sell groceries and also sell non grocery products and products necessary to maintaining the safety, sanitation and essential operations of residences;
- F. Food cultivation, including farming, livestock and fishing;
- G. Businesses that provide food, shelter and social services;
- H. Newspapers, television, radio, and other media services;
- I. Gas stations and auto supply, auto repair and related facilities
- J. Banks and related financial institutions;
- K. Day Care operations that supply care for children of essential workers;
- L. Hardware stores;
- M. Furniture stores that provide essential products for maintaining essential residences;
- N. Storage companies;
- O. Cosmetic and clothing stores;
- P. Plumbers, electricians, exterminators, janitorial and other service providers who provide services that are necessary to maintaining the safety, sanitation and essential operation of residences, essential activities and essential businesses;
- Q. Businesses providing mailing and shipping services, including post office boxes;
- R. Educational institutions-including private K-12 schools, colleges and universities for purposes of facilitating distance learning or performing essential services provided that social distancing of six-feet per person is maintained to the greatest extent possible;
- S. Laundromats, drycleaners and laundry service providers;
- T. Telecommunications, computer repair and security companies;
- U. Restaurants and other facilities that prepare and serve food, but only for delivery or carry out. Schools and other entities that typically provide free food services to students or members of the public may continue to do so under this Ordinance on the condition that the food is provided to students or members of the public on a pick up and take away basis only. Schools and other entities that provide food services under this exemption shall not permit the food to be eaten at the site where it is provided or any other gathering site;
- V. Businesses that supply products needed for people to work from home;
- W. Businesses that ship or deliver groceries, food, goods or services directly to residences;
- X. Taxis and other private transportation providers providing transportation services necessary for essential activities and other purposes expressly authorized in this ordinance;

- Y. Golf courses and outdoor recreation that maintains social distancing requirements;
- Z. Home based care for seniors, adults or children;
- AA. Residential facilities including hotels, motels, shared rental units and similar facilities and shelter for seniors, adults and children;
- BB. Professional services such as legal, accounting services, real estate services, insurance services and surveyors when necessary to assist in compliance with legally mandated activities;
- CC. Businesses that support and perform repair or construction work for business or homes;
- DD. Road construction, Grading, maintenance and repair and related Engineering and construction services;
- EE. Businesses providing the sale of outdoor equipment and machinery;
- FF. Businesses providing outdoor lawn, tree maintenance and timber companies;
- GG. Pawn and gun shops
- HH. Printing Services
- II. Federal, State, County and Municipal Services;
- JJ. Utilities (Gas, Electricity, phone and cable);
- KK. Funeral Homes, related service businesses (florists) crematories and cemeteries;
- LL. Trash Collection, processing and disposal;
- MM. Animal Shelters or animal care or management and crematories;
- NN. Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers as defined by US Department of Homeland Security and executed by the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency.
