



WHO WE ARE

63 YEARS AGO, in 1955, **First United Methodist Church of Coral Gables** established a scholarship program for Christian youth. Initially, the program provided scholarships only for students wishing to enter full-time professional church careers. Later, the program was broadened to include both scholarships and loans for church members with a financial need for study in other career areas. In 2015, the loan program was discontinued and the program was changed to a scholarship program.

The **FUMCCG Memorial Scholarship Program** is designed to honor students for their commitment to, and involvement in, the church and community as well as Christian character. The program seeks to provide financial assistance to full-time undergraduate students, seminary students, and graduate students who are members of **First United Methodist Church of Coral Gables**. Each year, students are invited to fill out an application and submit it to the church's scholarship committee, which is comprised of church members.

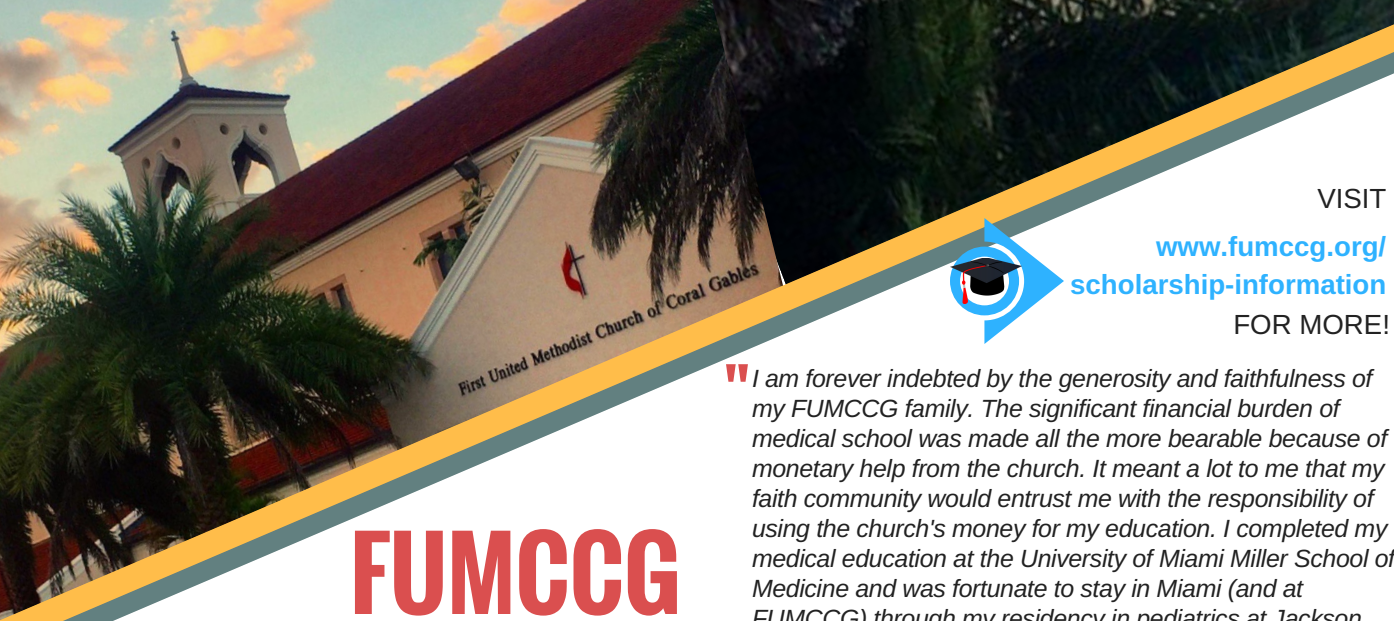
