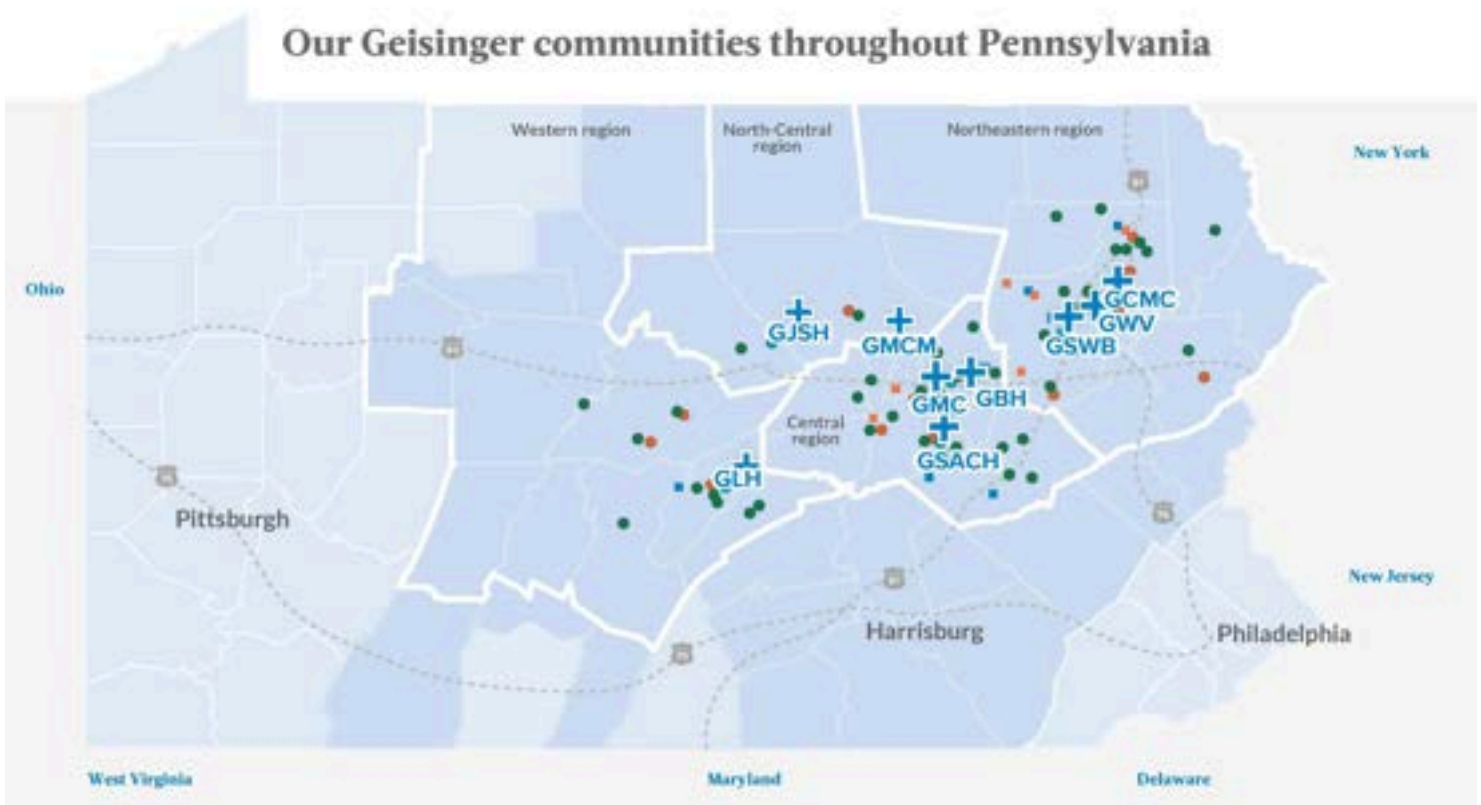

Highland Hospital delivers approximately 2500 babies per year and consistently maintains a Cesarean delivery rate below the national average. The responsibilities of this position will include inpatient and outpatient obstetrical management; newborn care; and teaching of fellows, residents and medical students.
