Primary Care Diabetology Fellowship

The one-year fellowship in Primary Care Diabetology is designed specifically to train physicians to become experts in diabetes care. With this training, you will be able to deliver care to people with diabetes across the care continuum as a diabetologist. Fellows who complete the program are eligible for board certification in diabetology.

Program Curriculum

Fellows will participate in outpatient diabetes care clinics, run the diabetes management consult service at a community hospital, complete specialty clinic rotations, participate in weekly didactics, conduct research, and attend continuing education courses. In addition, they will train in diabetes technology and ancillary services, including telemedicine, remote monitoring, nutrition and diabetes education, insulin pumps and continuous glucose monitoring systems.

Eligibility Requirements

- Graduate of an accredited family or internal medicine residency program in the United States
- Able to work within the United States; at this time, our program is not able to sponsor visas
- Excellent academic and clinical record
- Commitment to the care of underserved populations

Division Director of Geriatric Medicine

Jefferson Health and Thomas Jefferson University seek a visionary academic geriatrics leader to serve as the university's next Director of the Division of Geriatric Medicine.

Responsibilities

The successful candidate will lead the Division of Geriatrics within the Department of Family & Community Medicine at Sidney Kimmel Medical College of Thomas Jefferson University, building on the existing strengths of a dynamic and growing division, and establishing and pursuing a vision for the division's future.

The candidate must be board-certified in Geriatric Medicine and in either Family Medicine or Internal Medicine. The candidate will be appointed as a faculty member of Sidney Kimmel Medical College at the appropriate rank.

The Division of Geriatric Medicine comprises 9 faculty members who work in an interprofessional team environment that includes advanced practice clinicians, social workers, nursing, and pharmacy colleagues. The Division provides clinical services through the Center for Healthy Aging (CHA), an ambulatory practice in Center City, Philadelphia, that offers primary care geriatrics and memory assessments. CHA also includes a dedicated Pride program for LGBTQIA older adults. Ambulatory services are also offered at a community-based site in South Philadelphia and through a geriatric oncology practice embedded in the Sidney Kimmel Comprehensive Cancer Center. The Division provides inpatient consultations at Thomas Jefferson University Hospital and Methodist Hospital, including oversight of an ACE unit; residential and post-acute care services; and a home-based primary care program. The Division's educational programs include a thriving fellowship as well as educational programs for internal and family medicine residents, medical students, and interprofessional colleagues. Geriatrics faculty and fellows have a strong record of scholarly productivity within the division and in collaboration with research partners across the university.

As Division Director, the candidate will develop a strategic vision that builds on the Division's strong foundation and vibrant academic culture to guide faculty, clinicians, and staff in ongoing career growth and development. The Physician provides comprehensive patient-centered primary care to members of the LGBTQAI+ community and people living with or vulnerable to HIV. Clinically, this role provides gender affirming care including hormone therapy, comprehensive sexual wellness services, and the prevention, diagnosis, and management of HIV and related conditions in an outpatient primary care setting. As medical director of Pride Care at Jefferson Einstein, the role provides leadership for the Pride team, participates in enterprise-wide committees, and serves as a subject matter expert for the implementation of new treatments, protocols, and interventions related to gender affirming care. The Physician works collaboratively with nurse practitioners, nurses, social workers, and other interdisciplinary team members to deliver high-quality care, promote adherence to treatment, and improve long-term health outcomes. The ideal candidate is experienced in primary care, HIV care, gender affirming care, culturally competent, and committed to serving diverse and often underserved populations.

- Provide primary and specialized care to LGBTQAI+ patients or those patients living with HIV in an outpatient clinic setting
- Serve as physician leader for Pride Care at Jefferson Einstein; leads and contributes to the growth and development of Pride Care services, strategic planning, achievement of goals and benchmarks, represents the program internally and externally
- Perform comprehensive health assessments, including medical history, physical exams, and risk evaluations
- Diagnose and manage HIV infection and related comorbidities, including opportunistic infections
- Prescribe and manage gender affirming hormone therapy (GAHT)
- Prescribe and manage antiretroviral therapy (ART) and monitor treatment adherence and effectiveness
- Prescribe and manage pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) for individuals exposed to or vulnerable to contracting HIV
- Order, interpret, and follow up on diagnostic tests and laboratory results
- Provide preventive care, including vaccinations, STI screening, and comprehensive sexual health counseling
- Educate patients on disease management, medication adherence, and lifestyle modifications

Job Description

Through a recently awarded HRSA Primary Care Training and Enhancement (PCTE) grant, the Department of Family and Social Medicine is expanding its homeless healthcare education programs. Working closely with the Director of Homeless Healthcare Curriculum and residency leadership, the **Faculty Champion** will serve as a key member of the educational leadership team, advancing the integration of homeless healthcare throughout the residency curriculum through innovative clinical, educational, and community-based initiatives. This position offers substantial opportunities for professional growth through the development of educational programming, community partnerships, learner mentorship, faculty development, and educational scholarship.

Goals

1. To provide Family Medicine residents with outstanding clinical education and mentorship in homeless healthcare and community-based primary care through compassionate, evidence-based, patient-centered care.
2. To strengthen residency education through innovative curriculum development, experiential learning, and interdisciplinary partnerships focused on the care of people experiencing homelessness and other medically underserved populations.
3. To advance the Department of Family and Social Medicine's mission of health equity by integrating homeless healthcare, social medicine, and structural competency into residency education, clinical care, scholarship, and community engagement.
4. To serve as a clinician educator and role model who demonstrates excellence in teaching, professionalism, interdisciplinary collaboration, and trauma-informed care while fostering resident growth and lifelong learning.

Faculty Activities will include but not be limited to:

- Provide approximately four clinical sessions per week of direct patient care in supportive housing and other community-based homeless healthcare settings while supervising residents and learners in these environments.
- Provide approximately 2 clinical sessions per week of direct patient care at either the Family Health Center or Williamsbridge Family Practice.
- Participate in a shared, home-based telephone call schedule to support continuity of care for established clinic patients. Call responsibilities are limited in frequency, shared among faculty, and do not require in-person coverage.
- Provide one session per week of resident precepting within the Williamsbridge Family Practice Center, promoting high-quality ambulatory education and patient care.

- Supervise resident clinical experiences in supportive housing and other non-traditional healthcare settings, providing direct observation, formative feedback, and individualized coaching.
- Develop, implement, and evaluate educational experiences within the Montefiore-Einstein Family Medicine Residency Homeless Healthcare curriculum and the NYC Homeless Healthcare Fellowship.
- Develop and deliver didactic sessions on topics relevant to the care of marginalized populations.
- Mentor residents participating in the Homeless Healthcare Track and fellows enrolled in the NYC Homeless Healthcare Fellowship, supporting career development, scholarly activity, quality improvement initiatives, and professional growth.
- Collaborate with behavioral health providers, social workers, legal partners, community-based organizations, and other interdisciplinary professionals to develop meaningful clinical and educational experiences for residents.
- Participate in faculty development activities through the Clinician Educator Institute in Homeless Healthcare (CEIHH), while contributing to the development of faculty engaged in homeless healthcare education.
- Participate in program evaluation, quality improvement initiatives, and educational scholarship designed to strengthen homeless healthcare education and improve learner outcomes.
- Participate in residency educational conferences, faculty meetings, committee work, and other departmental activities as appropriate.

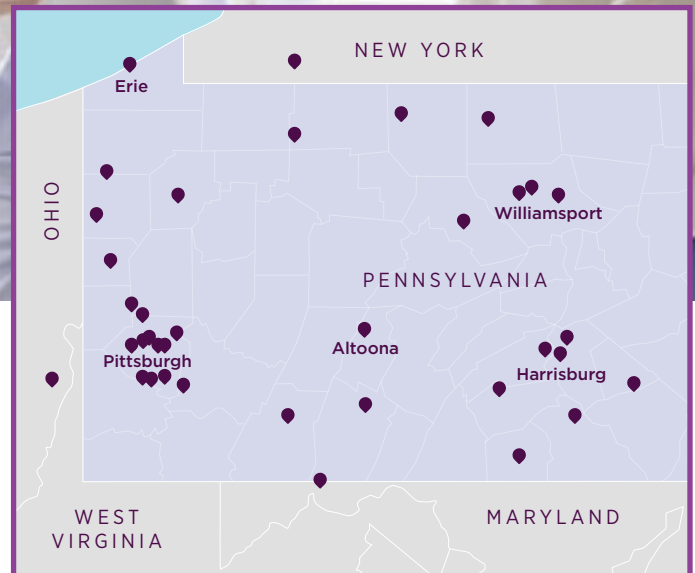

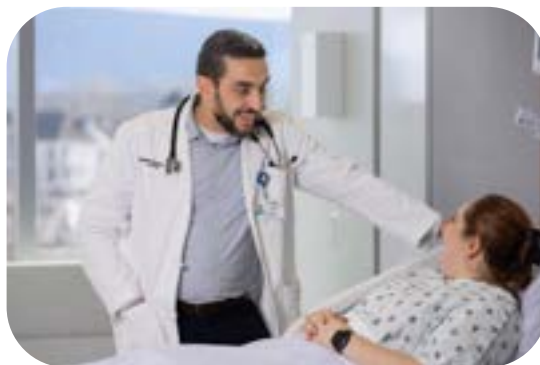

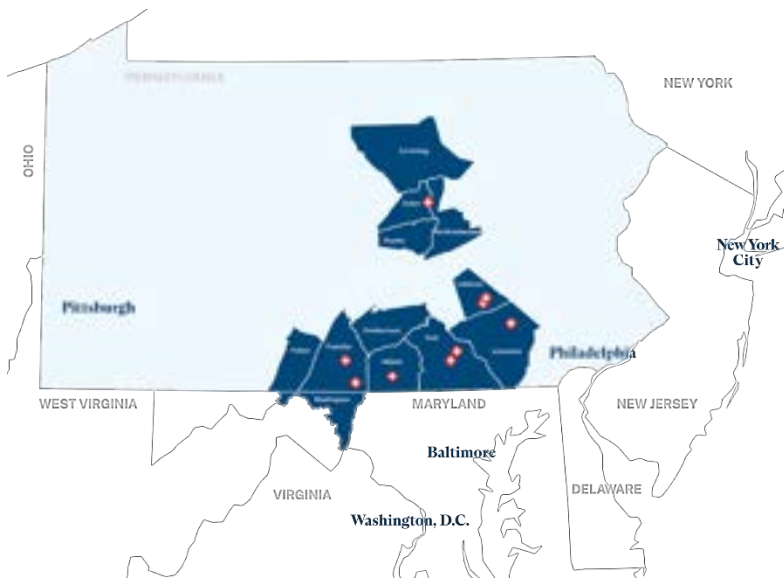
