WHY HEP B?





1 in 12 Asian American and Pacific Islander adults are chronically infected with hepatitis B.



2 out of 3 people who have hepatitis B don't know they have it.



1 in 4 people chronically infected with unmanaged hepatitis B will develop liver cancer or liver disease.



Hepatitis B is the leading cause of liver cancer in the entire world.



Over **81,000** people in the Bay Area alone are estimated to have chronic hepatitis B.

LAW — California law requires hepatitis B and hepatitis C tests to be offered in primary care settings.



SCREENING — The CDC recommends universal adult hepatitis B screening.

VACCINATION — The CDC recommends near universal hepatitis B vaccination.

THE HEP B TRIFECTA

There is no cure for hepatitis B, but there does exist **EFFECTIVE TREATMENT** that can **PREVENT** serious illness related to hepatitis B.

OUR MISSION

Our mission is to increase awareness and education about hepatitis B within the community and among health care providers, to improve the standards of care around affordable testing and vaccination following CDC recommendations and California law, and provide linkage to care for chronically affected individuals.

OUR MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS

- Education and Screening: Screened over 27,500 people and educated over 2,750,000 people through radio, billboards, TV, bus ads, and direct contact
 - Nearly 50% of those screened were unprotected and would benefit from vaccination
- <u>Physician Education</u>: Held dozens of education sessions with over 1,670 physicians pledging to screen their at-risk patients for hepatitis B
- <u>Business Partnerships</u>: Worked with over 1,500 businesses and 3,000 employees as part of the Business Initiative to
 educate hard-to-reach APIs
- <u>Wide-Scale Education</u>: Broadcasted hundreds of ethnic media commercials/PSAs and created public health awareness campaigns and a nationally-recognized, city-wide billboard campaign "Which One Deserves to Die?"
- Health Partnerships: Partnered with major healthcare groups in San Francisco and San Mateo
- <u>Legislation</u>: Successfully lobbied the California legislature to dedicate \$8 million across 3 years to adult chronic hepatitis
 B demonstration projects in California

WHY WE DO WHAT WE DO

The San Francisco Bay Area has one of the highest rates of liver cancer in the nation, likely due to the large Asian Pacific Islander (API) population and their high incidence of chronic hepatitis B infection. There was a huge need for a public health awareness campaign. Thus, SF Hep B Free was born.

SF Hep B Free—now "Hep B Free"—has made a lasting impact on hepatitis B and liver cancer awareness. By bringing together local stakeholders including government, healthcare, business, media, and advocacy groups, Hep B Free created a model for effective grassroots education, increased community screening, and compelling health advocacy.

2024-2025 ACHIEVEMENTS

- Organization rebranding to "Hep B Free" to signify our commitment to creating a hep B free community everywhere
- Launched a major Hep B Free collaboration project that will support regional hepatitis B awareness organizations across the US over the next 2 years
- Significant media attention and press coverage, including articles with the New Yorker, the San Francisco Chronicle and SF Public Press
- Held over 100 events, directly educating over 3,500 and screening over 300

CURRENT PROJECTS

- Supportive collaborations starting with Hep B Free LA and Hep B Free Arizona
- Planning 2026 California Hep B Free Summit
- Adding hepatitis B to UCSF ECHO program
- Working on Blueprint Project aimed at reducing barriers to healthcare systems looking to improve hepatitis B screening, vaccination, and linkage to care
- Creating more Living with Hep B YouTube videos to fight the stigma around the disease
