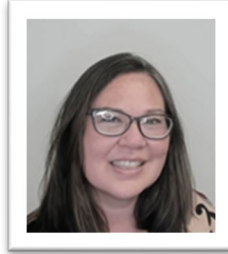

The Executive Office welcomes Theresa Juelch to the Grants Division. Theresa specializes in grant management and brings extensive experience across Tribal, nonprofit, private and public-sector systems. She is recognized for her expertise in managing the full grant lifecycle—from procurement and application development to compliance, reporting and program analysis—while supporting complex, multi-partner initiatives with accuracy and accountability. She maintains strong working relationships with California and federal agencies, supporting effective and compliant grant implementation.

Theresa most recently served as Environmental Planner for the Sherwood Valley Band of Pomo Indians, where she procured and managed a diverse portfolio of environmental and community development grants supporting climate resilience, land stewardship and workforce development. She also served as Administrative Director for California Open Lands, an Indigenous-led land management trust, where she stewarded grant management systems and advanced workforce development initiatives.

At United Way of Northern California, she served as a Community Investment Specialist, where she led outreach and supported applicant identification for the North State Equity Fund, facilitated equitable grantmaking and coordinated the distribution of funds. She also provided sub-grant management for Butte County's ESG-CV2 funding, supporting medical respite and non-congregate sheltering programs. In addition, she managed budgets and reporting for public health grants in collaboration with the California Office of Community Partnerships and Strategic Communications (OCPSC) as well as contributed to Disaster Response, Relief and Resiliency initiatives across the region. Her background also includes grant management and program support for Chico Housing Action Team, Regional Center clients and an international values-based leadership organization. Outside of work, Theresa serves as a board member of the ACLU of Northern California.
