Civil Service Commission

In 1962, Mendocino County voters adopted a Civil Service system, establishing the Civil Service Commission (CSC). The CSC is a five-member body appointed by the Board of Supervisors to uphold fair, merit-based hiring and employment practices. The Commission adopts, modifies, and abolishes classification specifications, oversees recruitment and examination processes through the Civil Service Rules, and hears and decides on application, exam, and employee
