MONTHLY OPERATIONAL UPDATE

An Safe and Healthy Community

Facility Maintenance & Operations:

Facility staff coordinated efforts with a local arborist to combat the discovery of catastrophic failure of the body of one of the prized Magnolia trees in front of the Ukiah Courthouse. A split between the two main segments of the tree was discovered and immediate action was taken to attach bindings to the upper portion of the tree to maintain the area safe for the general public. Additionally, a substantial amount was removed from the tree branches to lighten the load and extend the life of the tree. The arborist will continue to provide monthly checks. **Total cost was \$12,750.**

Fleet Operations:

Staff has received 22 brand new Sheriff's Office interceptors that are being coordinated and transported for outfitting for use.

Maintenance Operations:

Due to the recent inclement weather event, staff has been responding to downed trees, loss of power to report public safety sights, leaking roofs, and overflowing roadway drains. Facilities staff has prioritized the role of ensuring the safety and security to the maximum extent possible of the personnel working for the County as well as its residents. Multiple late-night trips have been made to extremely remote locations with many normally traveled roads closed, and trees blocking the only way in to the sights.
