## **Mendocino County Animal Care Services**

The Animal Care Services program areas include: Shelter, Clinic & Animal Protection Services; these programs provide animal education outreach, adoption, volunteer opportunities, fostering, lost & found services, feral cat trap-neuter-return programs, dog licensing, low cost spay & neuter, veterinary care, animal health education, rabies vaccinations, micro-chipping, impounding lost & stray animals, responding to injured-ill and suspected cruelty complaints and promoting responsible pet ownership.

### **Effective County Government**

During the month of May 2025, 3 cats & 12 dogs were adopted, 12 animals were returned to their owners, and 14 animals were transferred to other animal rescue organizations.

### **Safe and Healthy Community**

During the month of May 2025, the Animal Protection Unit worked 252 calls for service with 47 of the calls being categorized as priority such as "biting animals, cruelty complaints, animals in distress, aggressive loose animals and Law Enforcement Assist."

### **Thriving Economy**

During the month of May 2025, 517 dog licenses were sold resulting in \$19,914.00 in revenue being generated.

### **Prepared and Resilient County**

During the month of May 2025, 57 spay & neuter surgeries were performed in the Clinic, along with 66 rabies vaccinations being administered and 57 microchips implanted.

### **Caravan updates**

During the month of May 2025, 33 spay & neuter surgeries were performed on the Caravan, along with 34 rabies vaccinations being administered and 34 microchips implanted.

### **CA Adopt a Pet Day**

This year's California Adopt A Pet Day was a huge success. Volunteers, staff and community members came out in droves to support our Shelter animals. We wrapped the day up with 5 dog and 12 cat adoptions for a total of 17 adoptions. Dogs were also able to spend all day out of their kennels, spending time with volunteers and visiting families and our feline friends were a huge hit with the kids.
