November CEO Report

The Department of Agriculture and Weights & Measures celebrates the end of harvest for important agricultural commodities such as wine grapes, pears, and cannabis, among other minor crops, and the beginning of various winterization activities. We have completed critical California Department of Food and Agriculture Annual Financial Statements and County Annual Reports, which help provide additional funding.

We want to remind our ranchers, farmers, and growers of the importance of reporting their crop statistics for Mendocino County's annual Crop Report. The Department is updating these surveys so they can be submitted electronically on our website. The belated 2022 Crop Report is complete. We are seeking agricultural production data for 2023 and 2024.

Weights and Measures has just completed Electric Vehicle Charging Station inspections of the newer AC & DC fast-charging stations, in partnership with the CDFR's Division of Measurement Standards, to ensure customer confidence and compliance with state mandates.

As we prepare for the 2026 annual device registration billing cycle, the department would like to remind all Weights and Measures customers to review their commercial device registration account details to ensure accuracy. Any updates to mailing addresses, billing addresses, or device counts should be communicated to our office as soon as possible. Ensuring all account information, such as device counts and mailing addresses, is accurate and up to date to avoid delays or misdirected invoices. Billing statements will be sent out in December 2025, with a payment due date of February 15, 2026.

Additionally, please remember that all devices must be certified annually. Annual certification is an essential part of compliance and helps maintain the quality and reliability of registered devices. To accommodate device inspections, appointments are preferred because inspectors are frequently out in the field. **Appointments are available on Wednesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and Thursdays from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** Please get in touch with our office in advance to schedule your appointment at 707-234-6830 or agcomm@mendocinocounty.gov
