A star-shaped lantern displayed in homes in the Philippines, the Parol is meant to serve as the guiding light and sign for Mary and Joseph and more importantly, Jesus, to come into the home, as the family is ready for them.

The hanging home-made lanterns (parol) by the windows is another tradition that has persisted for centuries. It is not only a decoration, but a work of art that symbolizes unity with the community spirit of celebrating and honoring the birth of Jesus Christ.

The parols were used originally to illuminate the way of the churchgoers on their way to attend the traditional Misa de Gallo or **Simbang Gabi**.
