## Seattle Seafarers Center - Port of Seattle 9am -2pm. 18 and older

Tour the Seafarers Center and then board one of the cargo ships to meet the crew and hear their stories. Back to the Center for lunch and an assembly party, making Easter "ditty" bags for the seafarers.

## PrePS at St. Edward 10 am - noon 14 and up

Pregnancy & Parenting Support (PrePS) is an outreach program for pregnant women or caregivers with children 0 - 5 years old. Volunteers will help sort, organize, and clean the storage area and playroom.

Volunteers will tour the facilities and then help with general stable and facilities maintenance.

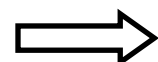
## Campus Projects at OLG and St. George

### Angeline's Day Center

10:30 am - 1:30 pm 12 and older

The center provides safety and support to more than 200 women every day. Volunteers will help prepare and serve lunch and visit with the women.

### Orion Center - West Seattle

11 am - 1 pm 18 and older

A safe and welcoming space for young people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Volunteers will prep, cook and serve a pre-planned meal. Covid Vaccination required

### Mary's Place - Burien

10 am - 1 pm 16 and older

Mary's Place - Burien is a safe place for 185 family members to stay with medical support for families experiencing homelessness with medically-fragile children. Volunteers will help them by sorting and organizing their hygiene & market place supplies.

### Tri-Parish Food Bank - Burlington

8:30am - 5:00pm All Ages

Volunteers will go to St. Charles in Burlington to help staff the Tri-Parish Food Bank used by migrant workers and others who are experiencing food insecurity.

### Santa Teresita - West Seattle

10 am - 3 pm All ages

A Catholic Housing Services program for 26 families. Help clean up and prep the garden area for planting.

### Rainier Valley Food Bank

8:30am - 11:00am 5 and older

Volunteers will help with the food distribution to 300 - 500 clients, stocking shelves, preparing stations for distribution, and cleaning up at the end of the shift. Masks and Covid Vaccination required

### Lutheran Immigration & Refugee Services

10 am - 3 pm All ages

LIRS stands with and advocates for migrants and refugees. They have a storage space in West Seattle that is need of organizing.

### Westside Baby - White Center

10am - 2pm Ages 8 and older

WSB provides essential items to children in need. Volunteers will sort and bundle supplies.
