Not sure if you require CEUs? Please read below.

Interpreters interested in obtaining continuing education credit (CEU) are those who have passed one of the national medical interpreter exams offered by The National Board of Certification for Medical Interpreters or the Certification Commission for Healthcare Interpreters and received one of the following credentials: CMI, QMI, CHI, or CoreCHI.

If you are interested in CEUs from the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID), you will need to contact a RID Approved CMP sponsor at least one week BEFORE the conference to receive a form to apply for a PINRA (Participant Initiated Non-RID Activities). Delay in contacting a CMP sponsor may result in not being awarded CEUs for the conference. If you need documentation from us, please email AHECMAIL@umassmed.edu.
